

Coach in Chief Report

We have several projects in the planning stages that we have placed on hold until we see what USAH is delivering as content for the new on line coach modules that will be required for all coaches this year. We were promised access to the modules so we could review them in advance but so far that has not happened.

The projects include video presentations of an ADM clinic and video segments from level 1-2-3 on ice sessions that will be done in District 6. These will be posted to the MNH website for use by associations.

The Local association skills sessions are getting scheduled and we have added body contact to the curriculum.

A progressive body contact video series is currently in development. Although coaches will see presentations from USAH, once they take the module they will not be able to see it again. We will do these so coaches can return to them for review at any time.

We are also refining a bantam development program that we would like to implement next fall. An update will be available at the winter meeting.

Several of us presented at the Level 4 clinic in Moorhead this past weekend. Thanks to Dennis Bushy and the Moorhead Youth Hockey Association for making the facility available and welcoming us.
