Elementary School Building Policies:

1. No food or drinks allowed anywhere in the school. Water during games is allowed, but the bench area must be cleaned up after each game.
2. No wet shoes or boots in the gyms – have players wear shoes/boots other than those worn for basketball to the gym, then change into their basketball shoes for practices and games.
3. No early drop-offs for practices – especially for the early practice times.
4. No late pick-ups. Be on time for the end of practice – especially for the last practice of the evening. Coaches are responsible for their players, but please do not ask them to baby sit your son.
5. There are to be no children left unattended in the hallways or anywhere in the building. All unattended minors will be asked to join their parents in the gyms.
6. Running or other game play is not allowed in the hallways.
7. Basketballs are to be used in the gyms **ONLY!!!** No bouncing basketballs in the hallways at any time.
8. A custodian must be notified if a player is hurt. Blood must be cleaned up by trained custodians. There is a first aid kit at the school.
9. Upon noticing any damage to the facilities, please immediately notify a custodian. It is also recommended that you notify your grade level director or the in-house director immediately after your practice or game is completed.
10. Referees are to be treated with respect at all times by coaches, players, parents and fans.
11. We all must remember that since we are given the opportunity to use these buildings, we need to respect the custodians and the facilities.
12. Our use of the facilities is for the gyms only, not the hallways. Players should be in the gyms and siblings should **NEVER** be left unattended during practices and/or games.
13. Coaches are responsible for the facilities when in use, but since they are in the gyms with the players, it's difficult for them to see what's going on in the hallways. Don't let them down.
14. The greatest concern is that if any other issues arise, we are subject to losing access to any of the schools for both practices and games. This would be detrimental to our program and most importantly to the boys.
15. Coaches and Level Coordinators will be asked to pay attention to their surroundings while the schools are in use.
16. If there are any policy infractions, practices and/or games may be suspended indefinitely.
