

RICE LAKE HOCKEY ARENA RULES

The Rice Lake Hockey Arena is owned, operated and maintained by the members of the association. In order to keep it a functional and financially stable organization, the following rules exist:

1. No playing with hockey sticks, hockey pucks or balls in the lobby or upstairs viewing area. All dryland skills can be practiced in the northwest corner of the building in the dryland training area.
2. The Blue Line Room is intended to be a space for Rice Lake adults to watch a game. That being said, this is a family facility. If you must have your child in the Blue Line Room, it is expected that they will be supervised. Please be considerate of other adult spectators and keep children under control or they may be asked to leave. There is no food or beverages allowed in the Blue Line Room.
3. Kids are not allowed in the concessions area. However, being a volunteer run organization of families, we understand that circumstances arise when a parent will be working and need to have a child with them or need to be accessible to them. Therefore, no one under the age of 16 is allowed to handle food or money in the concessions area.
4. Hockey players must be supervised by an adult at all times. During Christmas break, early release afternoons, and other non-coach supervised situations, adult supervision is required or players will be asked to leave the ice.
5. This is your rink – please help take care of it.
6. If you make a mess, please clean it up.
7. Put things back where you found them.
