**Discussion held on play up rule wording in Parent Hand book Motion made to accept revised language: Skating at a Higher Age Classification**

1. USA Hockey rules allow players to play up one age group. The Southwest Eagles Youth Hockey Association will allow a player to play up one age group, if after participating in tryouts at the older classification, the player's total tryout score is in the top five for that older classification. If the player's total tryout score is not in the five for the older classification the player will be placed on a team at their age classification based on tryout scores at that level. The Southwest Board of Directors may make exemptions to this policy if a majority vote of the Board decides that the situation warrants special consideration due to number of skaters at each of the age divisions affected.
2. If a player chooses to tryout at an older age classification that player will also be required to tryout at their normal age classification.
3. This policy is primarily for players that have demonstrated exceptional skills and by playing up they will have the opportunity to compete at a level that is appropriate for their skill level.
4. A player may move up only one age classification.
5. Players requesting to play up must obtain a recommendation from the Coaches Committee and notify the appropriate Division Director by the first Sunday in September. A player will be allowed to tryout at the older age classification unless the Board of Directors determines that it will adversely affect team sizes at either age classification.
6. All requests to play up require the parent, player and ACE Director signatures.

**The Southwest Board is responsible for the success of the entire organization will consider the effects of adding a player to a team before granting permission to any player to tryout for a higher level.**
