Register For Twitter As A First Time User

Two ways to register for a Twitter account:

- 1) You may register online at www.twitter.com. This is the more comprehensive way to register for your new Twitter account. With this method, you are able to review and manage all your settings, rather than just a few if you register via mobile device as in step #2 below.
- 2) You may also register for a Twitter account from your mobile device via text message.
 - To register from your mobile device via text message, open your text messaging and in the text message address field type the # “40404” and in the body of the text message type “start”.

In a few seconds you will receive a reply from Twitter...then...

- Respond to the reply from Twitter by texting “signup”

Follow the prompts and in just a few easy steps you will be registered for Twitter.

To Follow A Person Or Group

Upon registering for Twitter, you must then instruct Twitter to “follow” the username (account/person or group) you want to follow. The list of commands below can be used to instruct Twitter -from your mobile device by way of text messaging- to apply certain functions, based on your preferences:

To command Twitter to perform any of the following commands, in the address field of your text message, type the # “40404”. In the body of the text message, type the command code below to perform the associated task:

Follow *username*

This will have you follow the person/group and turn on your notifications so that you get Twitter text messages sent to you on your mobile device. For example, ***follow trojanlax***

Unfollow *username*

This will have you unfollow, or disable your option to receive Twitter text messages from this person/group. This command is used for when you no longer wish to receive Twitter text messaging. Example: ***unfollow trojanlax***

@*username*

This allows a user to send a direct message to the username being followed. The application here is when there is a need to send the username important information that may be relative to a just received tweet. For example: @trojanlax game is moved to field #4. Trojanlax can then retweet this important information to all followers of trojanlax.
