

GHLL 2018 All Star Selection Process

Goal

The goal of the All Star Selection Process is to organize the **best possible team to compete, represent the League favorably, and win in the All Star Tournaments.**

Player Eligibility

In order to be considered for All Star selection a player will have to have been on a roster at the AAA, Majors, Junior, or Senior divisions for the spring 2018 season and have met the 2018 Little League rulebook tournament player eligibility requirements. One of these requirements is participating in 60% of the spring season's scheduled games, except for players that provide a physician's note documenting an injury or illness prior to or during the current season prohibiting his/her participation and such note releases the player for the balance of the Regular Season and/or Tournament Play.

Players league age 14 who participated in 60% of the senior season are eligible for both the 15/16 year old team and the 13/14 year old team.

Players league age 11 are eligible for both the 10/11 and the 11/12 year old teams.

Players league age 10 are eligible for both the 9/10 and the 10/11 year old teams.

Player Selection Process

- All players who meet Little League eligibility rules and have completed the "All Star Commitment" form are eligible to be selected as All Star players.
- For the Seniors, Juniors, Majors, 10/11, and 9/10 All Star teams, the Player Agent will create ballots with all eligible and committed players' names on each ballot. Each Manager and coach of record will vote for 14 All Star candidates.
- Only coaches of record are eligible to vote. Coaches of record are defined as appointed Manager and appointed First Coach.
- AAA Managers and coaches of record vote for the 9/10 year old All Stars.
- Major Managers and coaches of record vote for the 10/11 and 11/12 year old All Stars.
- Junior Managers and coaches of record vote for the 13/14 year old All Stars.
- Senior Managers and coaches of record vote for the 15/16 year old All Stars.
- The top 10 vote recipients in each category are automatically selected to the All Star team. If a player is selected to more than one team, the player and player's parents will provide their preference upon which team they will participate.
- The All Star manager selects the remaining players for the team. These players will be selected from up to the next 8 top vote recipients. (The teams will have a minimum of 12 players and a maximum of 14 players, decided upon by the All Star Manager.)
- Players will be notified on the GHLL.net website of their selection to the All Star team.
- If the candidate is unable to meet the All Star proof of eligibility requirements or elects not to play for a team. Another player will be selected by the All Star Manager from the 6 remaining top vote recipients.
- All ties in voting will be broken by the league President.
- Ballots are counted and verified by the Player Agent and President.
- The vote will be conducted as a "secret ballot", with no indications on the ballot to identify the coach casting the ballot.

All Star Manager Selection Process

The Golden Hill Little League Board of Directors will accept volunteers interested in coaching All Stars and recommend All Star managers for appointment by the President, and approval by the Board of Directors. One All Star Manager will be selected for each All Star team. The All Star Managers will be selected after the voting for the players has been completed.

Requests for participation in the selection process must be submitted no later than 5/15/18. Appointed All Star managers will be able to select up to two (2) coaches for appointment by the President, and approval by the Board of Directors. If the President requests to manage or coach an All Star team, the Board of Directors will appoint the manager/coach for that team.

Managers and coaches of the All Star team must meet Little League rule book eligibility requirements and be committed to producing a championship team.

All Star managers will be announced and posted to the website on the same day the team is announced.
