



All-Star Player Selection Process

11/12 Division

The IRLLE All-Star committee will consist of the baseball committee members and the division commissioners.

Twelve or Thirteen (12/13) players shall be selected to the Little League All-Star Team. The All-Star Committee shall administer the voting process.

All players who are "league age" 12 or 11 and have participated in the Intermediate Division and played at least 60% of the regular season games are eligible.

The Little League All-Star Team Player Selection procedure shall be as follows:

Managers will distribute a commitment letter to every player on their team. Each player's parents will be required to sign the commitment letter to be eligible for placement on the 12 year-old All-Star ballot. Should a player or player's parent not sign the commitment letter, or decline selection to the All-Star team, then that player's name cannot be included on the All-Star ballot.

Intermediate managers will meet to nominate players to be considered for the Little League ballot.

Final selection to the Little League All-Star Team is as follows:

1. Each eligible Intermediate manager shall vote for the players to be represented on the Little League All-Star Team and shall vote for six (6) players on their ballot. Ballots with less than 6 or more than 6 votes will be invalid. The managers may vote for players from their own team as well as their own child.
2. Six (6) players shall be automatically selected for the All-Star team based upon the top six (6) total manager vote tallies.
3. The next five (5) players automatically selected for the All-Star team shall be those remaining players that have been selected by managers. In the event that two players are in a vote tie for the sixth position (in the initial vote) then both players will be awarded All-Star positions and the managers will fill only four (4) positions.
4. The final player, for a total of twelve or thirteen players, will be selected for the All-Star team by the All-Star team manager from the remaining list of players on the All-Star ballot, not including their own child. This selection is subject to All-Star Committee approval. If the manager chooses not to select the final player(s), the All Star Committee shall be responsible for the final selection(s).
5. All-Star Committee may decide all ties.

11 Division

Twelve or Thirteen (12/13) players shall be selected to the 11 All-Star Team. The All-Star Committee shall administer the voting process.

All players who are "league age" 11 and have participated in the Intermediate division and played at least 60% of the regular season games are eligible.

The 11 All-Star Team Player Selection procedure shall be as follows:

Managers will distribute a commitment letter to every player on their team. Each player's parents will be required to sign the commitment letter to be eligible for placement on the 11 year-old All-Star ballot. Should a player or player's parent not sign the commitment letter, or decline selection to the All-Star team, then that player's name cannot be included on the All-Star ballot.

Intermediate managers will meet to nominate players to be considered for the Little League ballot.

Final selection to the 11 All-Star Team is as follows:

Final selection to the Little League All-Star Team is as follows:

1. Each eligible Intermediate manager shall vote for the players to be represented on the Little League All-Star Team and shall vote for six (6) players on their ballot. Ballots with less than 6 or more than 6 votes will be invalid. The managers may vote for players from their own team as well as their own child.
2. Six (6) players shall be automatically selected for the All-Star team based upon the top six (6) total manager vote tallies.
3. The next five (5) players automatically selected for the All-Star team shall be those remaining players that have been selected by managers. In the event that two players are in a vote tie for the sixth position (in the initial vote) then both players will be awarded All-Star positions and the managers will fill only four (4) positions.
4. The final player, for a total of twelve or thirteen players, will be selected for the All-Star team by the All-Star team manager from the remaining list of players on the All-Star ballot, not including their own child. 9/10 Division

The IRLR All-Star committee will consist of the baseball committee members and the division commissioners.

Twelve or Thirteen (12/13) players shall be selected to the 9/10 All-Star Team. The All-Star Committee shall administer the voting process.

All players who are "league age" 10 or 9 and have participated in the AAA or AA Division and played at least 60% of the regular season games are eligible.

The 9/10 All-Star Team Player Selection procedure shall be as follows:

Managers will distribute a commitment letter to every player on their team. Each player's parents will be required to sign the commitment letter to be eligible for placement on the 9/10 year-old All-Star ballot. Should a player or player's parent not sign the commitment letter, or decline selection to the All-Star team, then that player's name cannot be included on the All-Star ballot.

AAA Managers and AA Managers will meet to nominate players to be considered for the 9/10 ballot.

Final selection to the 9/10 All-Star Team is as follows:

1. Each eligible AAA and AA manager shall vote for the players to be represented on the 9-10 All-Star Team and shall vote for six (6) players on their ballot. Ballots with less than 6 or more than 6 votes will be invalid. The manager may vote for players from their own team as well as their own child.
3. AAA managers' selections shall count four (4) votes each. AA managers' selections shall count one (1) vote each.
4. Six (6) players shall be automatically selected for the All-Star team based upon the top six (6) total manager vote tallies.
5. The next five (5) players automatically selected for the All-Star team shall be those remaining players that have been selected by managers only. In the event that two players are in a vote tie for the sixth position (in the initial vote) then both players will be awarded All-Star positions and the managers will fill only four (4) positions. In addition, two (2) alternate players will be selected by the managers to be used if a player must leave the team.
6. The final player(s), for a total of twelve or thirteen players, will be selected for the All-Star team by the All-Star team manager from the remaining list of players on the All-Star ballot, not including their own child. This selection is subject to All-Star Committee approval. If the manager chooses not to select the final player(s), the All Star Committee shall be responsible for the final selection(s).

8/9 Division

The IRLLE All-Star committee will consist of the baseball committee members and the division commissioners.

Twelve or Thirteen (12/13) players shall be selected to the 8/9 All-Star Team. The All-Star Committee shall administer the voting process.

All players who are "league age" 9 or 8 and have participated in the AAA or AA Division and played at least 60% of the regular season games are eligible.

The 8/9 All-Star Team Player Selection procedure shall be as follows:

Managers will distribute a commitment letter to every player on their team. Each player's parents will be required to sign the commitment letter to be eligible for placement on the 8/9 year-old All-Star ballot. Should a player or player's parent not sign the commitment letter, or decline selection to the All-Star team, then that player's name cannot be included on the All-Star ballot.

AAA Managers and AA Managers will meet to nominate players to be considered for the 8/9 ballot.

Final selection to the 8/9 All-Star Team is as follows:

2. Each eligible AAA and AA manager shall vote for the players to be represented on the 8-9 All-Star Team and shall vote for six (6) players on their ballot. Ballots with less than 6 or more than 6 votes will be invalid. The manager may vote for players from their own team as well as their own child.
4. AAA managers' selections shall count three (3) votes each. AA managers' selections shall count one (1) vote each.
8. Six (6) players shall be automatically selected for the All-Star team based upon the top six (6) total manager vote tallies.
9. The next five (5) players automatically selected for the All-Star team shall be those remaining players that have been selected by managers only. In the event that two players are in a vote tie for the sixth position (in the initial vote) then both players will be awarded All-Star positions and the managers will fill only four (4) positions. In addition, two (2) alternate players will be selected by the managers to be used if a player must leave the team.
10. The final player(s), for a total of twelve or thirteen players, will be selected for the All-Star team by the All-Star team manager from the remaining list of players on the All-Star ballot, not including their own child. This selection is subject to All-Star Committee approval. If the manager chooses not to select the final player(s), the All Star Committee shall be responsible for the final selection(s).
