

Field Maintenance Guidelines



Practice Goals -

- Practicing Teams must utilize practice goals during training
- Practice goals should be erected width-wise across the field.
- Practice goals should be taken down at the end of training and returned to the storage pens when not in use. All goals should be in the pens on Thursday evening to accommodate the mowers on Friday.

Permanent Goals –

- Teams must not use permanent goals during training, and they may not be moved.
- Teams must not conduct a pre-game warm up in the penalty area for scrimmages, games, tournaments, or Friendlies. Visiting teams must follow these same guidelines.
- Teams may not conduct shooting practice or Goalkeeper training in permanent goals.
- Siblings and parents must not use permanent goals before, during, or after team training.

Field Maintenance –

- Teams must police their area of bottles, tape, and personal items before the end of training sessions.
- Speed training must be conducted well off the playing areas of each field.
- Players, parents, or coaches should fill divots and holes with dirt provided by the club.

Safety Issues

- Lights must be turned off when leaving the field.
- Bathrooms must be secured, and the front gate must be locked if you are the last to leave.
- Cars must park in painted spaces, but not in Gate areas.
- Parking is not allowed along the curb beside fields, or along the fence at field 13.
- Vandalism and/or destruction of city property should be reported to club officials ASAP.

Field Assignments –

- Teams must practice on assigned spaces.
- Changes in a team's practice schedule must be sent to the club administrator and cleared.
- Teams may train at the complex provided their Field Maintenance Fee has been paid.

Scrimmages –

- Teams must limit the number of full-length scrimmages unless preparing for a tournament. (this does not include shortened inter-squad scrimmages)
- Scrimmages must be requested and approved no less than 5 days before the scrimmage. The game field should not be changed.
- Damage to the fields or facility will be the responsibility of the coach requesting the scrimmage. The requesting coach is responsible for trash removal, lights, restrooms, and complex closure.
- If referees are needed, they MUST be hired and assigned thru the club assignor at the club scrimmage rate. Referees may not work scrimmages without being assigned by the club. Doing so will jeopardize both the referee and the club.
