## Dear Parents/Guardians of 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Boys:

The 2016-17 Lake City Elementary Basketball season for boys in 5<sup>th</sup> grade is quickly approaching. The purpose of the Lake City boys youth basketball program is to provide opportunities for all boys in grades 4-6 to learn the fundamentals of the game, develop skills, play in competitive situations, and have fun. Because we realize that we have kids and parents at different commitment levels, we have developed two registration options for kids to get involved. Also, players will receive new reversible jerseys during their 3rd and 5th grade years in the program. Players in grade 4 will receive their own indoor basketball to be used at practices.



**OPTION 1: 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Youth Basketball:** The boys youth basketball program will run on various Monday nights from 7:30-8:30 p.m. at Bluff View Elementary throughout the winter season (Mid-November – Early February); practices will focus on building fundamental skills. Players participating in option 1 will practice one day/week (Monday) and will play in 2-3 Saturday Tournaments (there are usually two games played on each Saturday tournament in a neighboring town). **The first practice is set to begin on Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> from 7:30 pm - 8:30 pm at Bluff View.** Complete schedules will be handed out at the first practice. The cost of the youth program will be \$40. The coaches of the 5<sup>th</sup> grade basketball program will be Jason Lorensen and other parent volunteers.

**OPTION 2: 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Youth Basketball + Traveling Basketball:** The 5<sup>th</sup> grade youth + traveling basketball commitment will include the same practice times as Youth Basketball (all 5<sup>th</sup> graders, youth and traveling, will practice together), as well many additional practices (Thursdays and Sundays), throughout the winter. The traveling basketball season will begin in November (Coach Lorensen will contact you with the first practice time) and continue through February. Kids participating in Option 2 will typically practice three days/week (Monday, Thursday, and Sunday) and play in 8-9 weekend tournaments throughout the winter season. Option 2 will consist of a greater time and monetary commitment and is a more competitive environment. The cost of Option 2 will be \$100. The coaches of the 5<sup>th</sup> grade basketball program will be Jason Lorensen and other parent volunteers.
