▶ WINTER WARM UPS

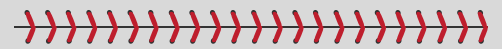

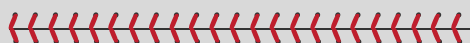


► UPCOMING COACHES CLINIC
