The Aroostook Amateur Hockey Association has established a “Code of Conduct” for the Parents of the youth involved in the Program. Please assist us in making hockey enjoyable to all in any and all arenas where we pursue the sport.

**AS A PARENT INVOLVED WITH THE PRESQUE ISLE YOUTH
HOCKEY ASSOCIATION I WILL:**

- 1 Always remember my child is involved in youth hockey for their enjoyment, not mine.
- 2 Always encourage my child to play by the rules.
- 3 Never ridicule or yell at my child for making a mistake or losing a game.
- 4 Always remember that young people learn best by example. Applaud good play-no matter the team.
- 5 Always remember my help with transportation to the “away” games is necessary to make the program work.
- 6 Always treat visitors to our forum with respect and dignity.
- 7 Never publicly question any referees and/or coaches judgment or honesty.
- 8 Leave the coaching of my child to qualified instructors (the Coaches).
- 9 Always support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse from hockey.
- 10 Always recognize the value and importance of coaches and officials. They give many hours of their time to provide hockey for your youth. Without them we have no program.

The rules listed below have been established by the Aroostook Amateur Hockey Association Executive Board as guidelines for the conduct of all and any participants in the organization.

**AS A PLAYER IN THE AROOSTOOK AMATEUR
HOCKEY ASSOCIATION I WILL:**

- 1 Obey all arena rules (as posted) both on and off the ice.
- 2 Accept the responsibility of leaving all dressing rooms home or away clean and orderly after each use.
- 3 Always maintain the integrity of the Aroostook Amateur Hockey Association and show pride and honor in competition.
- 4 Always treat all players, parents, opponents and officials with courtesy and respect.
- 5 Always act in an orderly manner while in any area. I realize that any inappropriate behavior or foul language will not be tolerated.
- 6 Always respect my team coach (s) and manager (s) both on and off the ice.
- 7 Always attempt to be “dressed” and ready at least 10 minutes prior to my scheduled ice time.
- 8 Always inform my coach or manager if I am unable to attend a scheduled game or practice.
- 9 Understand that the use of tobacco, alcohol and/or other drugs will result in a suspension for a period of time to be determined by the Committee.

As Parents and Players registered with Aroostook Amateur Hockey we realize the Penalty System written below will be used in situations when deemed necessary after review by the Complaint Committee. This Committee will enforce all penalties in all situations classed as "serious".

First Offence: Verbal warning by coach or manager

Second Offence: Single ice-time suspension by the coach

Third Offence: Seven (7) day suspension from all team activities by the Committee

Forth Offence: Suspension from all hockey team activities for remainder of season by the Committee
