Policy/Procedure: Mandatory Fundraising Policy – Policy AB



Amery Youth Hockey Association (AYHA) will have several fundraising events during each hockey season. Every family will have the choice of either participating in these fundraisers or choosing a buyout option.

Procedure:

1. The Board provides the opportunity for families to exceed the budgeted fundraiser amount and splits the excess profit with the Association. For every dollar of profit that exceeds the family minimum amount, the Association will credit 50% to the family's AYHA account.
 - a. These excess profits may be used for next year's registration fee; however, it is the family's responsibility to request the credit
 - b. The excess profits will not be paid out to families in cash
2. The Board provides a buyout option for those families choosing to not participate in the fundraising events.
 - a. The buyout dollar amount will be due at the end of the season banquet
3. Exceptions to the policy:
 - a. All skaters entering their final year with AYHA (Senior year) are required to pay the buyout amount at the time of registration
 - b. First year AYHA families will not be required to participate in these fundraisers. For first year families that do choose to participate in these fundraisers, the Association will split the profits 50/50 with the family. This profit may be applied toward the next season's registration fee
4. Statements will be sent to families as the end of the season approaches. Reminders will be sent periodically until we approach the new season registration. At that time all balances must be paid in full before a family can register for the new season



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
