Work Hour & Fundraiser Agreement

Volunteer Worker Agreement

I understand that AYHA is a completely volunteer organization and all registered families are members of AYHA. As a registered family with AYHA it is our responsibility to assist in the operations at the Amery Ice Arena during the hockey season (October – April) and in the off season (May-September). AYHA has put into place a work-hour policy to ensure all necessary work is done and divided fairly among the members.

- Each family is required to work 18 hours per player (40-hour family maximum) and 6 community skate hours (15-hour family maximum) starting from the first official scheduled AYHA practice until the end of the year banquet
- New families with AYHA are required to work 8 hours per player and 3 community skate hours
- Each family is required to work 10 hours per player (15-hour family maximum) from the end of the year banquet until the first official scheduled AYHA practice
- I agree to reimburse AYHA for work hours not completed at a rate of \$30 per hour
- I understand I can have any responsible adult do the work for me
- I understand my player can receive credit for work based upon what is outlined in the AYHA Work Hour Policy (Policy H)
- I understand it is my responsibility to record the work hours for my family via the work hour link provided at the beginning of the season

Fundraising Agreement

To keep the registration fees at a manageable amount for families AYHA put into place a mandatory fundraising policy (Policy AB) to raise a predetermined amount to go towards AYHA's operating budget. Two major fundraisers will be conducted each hockey season and each AYHA family member has the choice of participating in one, both, or none of the fundraisers.

- I understand that my family is required to sell \$300 total of either fundraiser or a combination of approved fundraisers. (1st year AYHA families are not required to participate, however, if they do, 50% of the profit they sell can be applied towards next year's hockey registration fees)
- I understand that my family can choose not to participate in the mandatory fundraiser by paying the \$250 buyout
- I understand that if my family does not sell \$300 total, my family is responsible for the difference between the profit dollar amount of what was sold and the required buyout amount of \$250
- I understand that if I sell more than the required \$300 in sales, I can apply 50% of the profit over the required \$250 profit amount towards next year's hockey registration fees

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- I understand all fundraising must be turned in and buyout amounts paid by the annual AYHA hockey banquet and meeting in April
- I understand if my skater is in their final year with AYHA (Senior year), I will pay the fundraising buyout amount at the time of registration

I have read the above policy procedure summaries and agree to abide by the terms of the agreements as outlined above.
