Vice-Commissioner Jeff Harvey called the meeting to order at 10:15 AM. Introductions were made and roll was called (attendance listed above).

Vice Commissioner-Treasurer Jeff Harvey noted that Commissioner Joe McInnis resigned. The position will remain vacant for this season. Elections occur in the Spring.

Harvey presented the Treasurer's report. The budget for 2014-2015 was discussed, and is attached. Report was approved unanimously.

Associations were reminded that the annual dues are now \$125/association, to cover the costs of the new Sport NGIN website hosting agreement.

Secretary-Statistician Walt Milligan discussed the new website, and the requirements that team representatives add scores themselves through the website. A handout was distributed for each team to get them started (attached).

It was agreed that the Spring 2015 meeting will occur on Saturday, April 18, 2015, at approximately 2:00 PM, at the Wawonowin Golf Course in Ishpeming, Michigan. Meeting will occur at the conclusion of the MAHA District 8 meeting, which starts at 10 AM.

Teams were proposed for each level, and divisions were assigned by unanimous consent.

At 10:50 AM, the CUPHL meeting adjourned, and representatives from member associations met to set the 2014/2015 CUPHL schedules.

CUP League Score Reporting Procedures

CUP League Directors (from each Association) unanimously approved a change in score reporting, starting last year in the 2013-2014 season.

The main change is as follows: "Each team in the League must appoint a team website representative. This representative shall enter all CUP League game scores directly into the CUP League website."

During the first year, the system worked reasonably well. About $\frac{3}{4}$ of the teams entered scores regularly, and at the end of the year we were only missing 13% of the game scores. This year, we would like to get all the teams participating, and receive most of the scores.

The team website representative can be a coach, manager, parent, the association scheduler (not recommended), or even a player in the older divisions. The person should be reasonably computer savvy, but honestly, if you have ordered something on amazon.com or bought/sold something on eBay, you should be able to handle this. I am very happy to help with people who have difficulties, by e-mail, on the phone, or in person. Representatives from last year should also be very helpful.
