Why: The Women's Beantown Classic is one of the most prestigious summer tournaments in female hockey. Teams match up and play in front of college scouts. Over the last four years the Women's Beantown has grown into the premier amateur showcase event in the United States. In 2014, 120+ teams participated and 180 scouts from EVERY major Women's NCAA Division I and Division III program attended. *For players interested in playing collegiate hockey, this is the place to be seen!*

Tryouts:

- Saturday, April 18, 2015 - 10:00 am to 11:00 am at OVA
- Saturday, April 18, 2015 - 2:00 pm to 3:00 pm at OVA
- Sunday, April 19, 2015 - 10:00 am to 11:00 am at OVA

*Note: Cuts will be made after each session

Practices:

- 3 one-hour practices to be held in the Seattle area approximately one week prior to the tournament
- Times and locations TBD

Costs:

- Tryouts - \$40
- Seattle Wild Team - \$479 - includes practices, coaches' travel and tournament fees
 - Payments are due at time of tryouts and team selection.
 - Team Fee does not include: summer hockey insurance, player airfare, hotel, rental car or food.
 - Practice weekend billeting available.
