1. Minutes

3. Unfinished Business

Kevin McWaters spoke about the Meet of Champions to be held on May 23. The CGSAA track meet at McGuinness on April 11 will be a qualifier for this meet. This year the Meet of Champions will be for fifth and sixth graders only. If a fifth or sixth grader from your school comes in first or second in the McGuinness meet, he/she will be contacted by Johnny Kitchen to see if he/she is interested in participating in the Meet of Champions. We will be able to send 20 students from each grade. Seventh and eighth grades will be added the following year.

CGSAA will order t-shirts for the Meet of Champions participants.

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 11. The rules, practice schedules, school responsibilities and schedule of events are on line. Please make sure that all track helpers and coaches get a copy of the rules, schedule of events and responsibilities.

The tug-of-war will start at 12:30 p.m. It is not counted as a field event and will not have a point value. The rules of the tug-of-war are posted on the website.

If you have equipment that you used at your assigned event last year (i.e. shot put, rakes for the long jump, tug-of-war rope), please bring it to the track meet.

Please have your volunteers ready at the beginning of their event. If you are having trouble finding volunteers, you can contact high school students who will be able to get community service hours for their participation.

Make sure that your track coordinator knows that in first and second grade, three children can compete in the running events only. Other than that exception only two children per school can participate in the different events.

You will need to enter the name, gender and grade of each child participating in the track meet by next Wednesday, April 8, at www.enduroentries.com. If you have trouble registering the students, call another school for assistance.

Each child will be assigned a number. The number needs to be written with a sharpie on the participants' hand the day of the meet.

The new system will work only if the children stay in their assigned lanes. Schools that are responsible for “positioning” will need to help make sure the kids start in the correct lanes.

8. PLACT

There will be a PLACT training session in late summer before the beginning of volleyball and soccer season. All volleyball and soccer coaches who coached last year will have to attend this session if they have not been trained in the past.
