1. Minutes

2. Treasurers Report

The fee for kindergarten is \$150 per team. You will also need to send PLACT training money. This can all be included in one check.

5. Volleyball

Mike Milligan sent money to the gyms for the officials, the score keepers and gym maintenance.

6. Basketball

Remember that the only game exception days are all-school, required functions.

Next month we will discuss the following two proposals.

Should we pay an extra fee for an official score keeper at all the basketball games? This would bring the league fee up about \$30 per team. The score keeper would also keep track of the participation rule in fourth through sixth grades.

Should we increase the tournament fee for Tulsa teams and add a fee for our teams to be able to eliminate the door charge for parents?
