6. Basketball

7. Track

The track meet will be held on April 12. The rules, practice schedules, school responsibilities and schedule of events are on line. Please make sure that all track helpers and coaches get a copy of the rules, schedule of events and responsibilities.

The tug-of-war will start at 12:30 p.m. It is not counted as a field event and will not have a point value. The rules of the tug-of-war are posted on the website.

If you have equipment that you used at your assigned event last year (i.e. shot put, rakes for the long jump, tug-of-war rope), please bring it to the track meet even if your school is not responsible for that event this year.

Please have your volunteers ready at the beginning of their event. If you are having trouble finding volunteers, you can contact high school students who will be able to get community service hours for their participation. The students need to bring the service hour forms to Dave Dunlevy.

Make sure that your track coordinator knows that only two children per school can participate in the different events.

You will need to enter the name, gender and grade of each child participating in the track meet by next Wednesday, April 9, at www.enduroentries.com. If you have trouble registering the students, call another school for assistance.

Each child will be assigned a number. The number needs to be written with a sharpie on the participants' hand the day of the meet.

The new system will work only if the children stay in their assigned lanes. Schools that are responsible for "positioning" will need to help make sure the kids start in the correct lanes.

The number of field events for 7th and 8th grade boys and girls changed to three. They can now run in three running events and participate in three field events.

Forms for the Hershey Track and Field Games were handed out at the meeting. The CGSAA meet is a qualifier meet. First and second place winners in qualifying events can go on to the State Hershey Meet at OU on June 28. There is no fee, and the winners at this meet are eligible for the Hershey meet in Hershey, Pennsylvania.

8. PLACT

Brittany gave a report on the results from the survey taken at the PLACT training session in January. Ninety percent of the participants were satisfied with the training session and eighty-eight percent will implement the concepts and strategies learned into their coaching style.

There will be another training session in early fall before the beginning of basketball season. All basketball coaches that have not been to the training will need to participate in the fall session to be able to coach next year.

9. New Business
