There will be a standing broad jump for 5th through 8th grade boys and girls. There will also be a softball throw for all grade levels, boys and girls.

Make sure that your track coordinator knows that only two children per school can participate in the different events.

No one will be needed in the press box at the track meet this year. Ribbons will be available approximately 30 minutes after the last event at the track meet.
