1. Minutes

2. Treasurers Report

The treasurer's report was approved.

3. Unfinished Business

The motion to rescind the basketball rule 33 about combining teams in the state tournament was defeated. The rule will stay the same as last year.

4. Soccer

Soccer is running smoothly. Many thanks to all who have helped get the season off to a good start. A special thanks to Alan Price for all your work!

The times for St. Eugene's games on October 31 will be changed. Watch for the time change on the website.

5. Volleyball

The games seem to be going well. Please have the gym coordinators fax the game scores to Matt on Monday or Tuesday. Matt has not gotten any scores from Rosary. He also needs the scores from St. Elizabeth's from the games on September 18 and 19.

Bishop McGuinness will host their annual Shamrock tournament on the weekend of October 23 -24. The application will be on our website, and Matt will email it to you.

The four top seventh and eighth grade teams from the Shamrock tournament will be invited to the state tournament the following weekend. The tournament will be held in Oklahoma City.

6. Basketball

The number of teams from each school was given to Barry at the meeting. Your school has until October 18 to make any changes. After that date, a fine of \$100 will be assessed for any changes in the number of teams from your school.

Your school will be fined the league fee if there are changes after the schedule has been completed.

Exception dates were also turned into Barry. An exception date is a day that a team can not play because of a school-scheduled event. Check your school calendars, and let Barry know if you have any dates that a team will not be able to play.

The "data form" sheet and "request for transfers" form (both signed by your principal) need to be given to Barry at the November meeting.

The team rosters and the basketball coaches' information sheet need to be turned in at the December meeting.

The fee will be \$355 per team. Basketball fees will be due at the November meeting.

You should have received a signup sheet for the Mid Town Fall classic. It will be held Nov. 6 – 7 and Nov. 13 -14. Cost for the tournament is \$100 if you register on or before October 20. After that date the fee will be \$150.

The Tulsa Tournament will be the first weekend in December. Only 7th and 8th grade teams may enter. All other grades will be starting the season with league games that weekend.

After the rules are set and posted on the website, please make sure that copies of the rules are given to each coach and made available to all families who will have children playing on a basketball team. After reading the rules each coach needs to sign the rules sheet. This sheet is due at the December meeting.

There will be a mandatory coaches meeting on November 3 at Bishop McGuinness gym at 7:00 pm. All coaches will be asked to sign in at that meeting.

8. New Business

We need to elect a new vice president. Come to the meeting in November with nominations. The vice president runs the meeting when the president is unavailable and votes on the executive committee. Hopefully he/she will become the president next year.
