### 1. Minutes

The minutes of the August meeting were approved.

### 2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer’s report was handed out.

Mike asked that all volleyball and soccer fees be brought to the October meeting or mailed to him at 4613 Stag Horn Dr., Yukon, OK 73099. Volleyball is \$285 per team. Soccer is \$215 for Divisions 1, 2 and 3. The fee for kindergarten is \$85 per team and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> costs \$160.

### 3. Unfinished Business

All-school rosters with birthdays are still needed from St. Charles, St. James and St. John’s Episcopal. Please fax these lists to Patty Phelps (528-4412) with the signature of your principal on each page.

#### 4. Soccer

**The number of teams from each school was turned in at the meeting. Please email Alan Price with any additions or corrections to your team count by Friday, September 3. He will set the schedule over the Labor Day weekend.**

Games will start the weekend of September 11. All games will be played at the Ione Branch of the YWCA. The schedule of the first weekend's games will be on the website before that weekend. The complete schedule should be on the website after the weekend of the 12<sup>th</sup>.

Kindergarten will not start until the following weekend.

Team rosters need to be handed in at the October meeting.

Larry Waite from St. Philip Neri will be helping Alan this year. Please remind coaches that there might be some problems as the soccer season gets under way. Have the coaches speak to the parents about the need to be patient as we start the first season in twenty-four years without Hank Tiarks to guide us.

#### 5. Volleyball

**The number of teams from each school was turned in at the meeting. Please email Matt Cooper with any additions or corrections to your team count by Friday, September 3. He will set the schedule over the Labor Day weekend.**

The volleyball games will begin on the weekend of September 11.

Matt will post the games that will be played on the 11 and 12 on the website. He will email you the rest of the schedule for the season, but it will not be posted on the website. Please check your schedule to make sure there are no errors. Do not share the season schedule with parents until after September 13. There might be changes.

Gyms coordinators should email your games' scores to Matt on Monday after that weekend's games.

A score sheet is available on the website. Please download it and use it at the games.

Mike Milligan will be sending money to the gyms for the officials, the score keepers and gym maintenance. He will be sending this to the schools each week.

#### 6. Basketball

The number of school teams and exception dates are due at the October meeting. Also due at the October meeting is the CGSAA & Gym Data Form with any gym exception dates. You will be able to access these forms on line at cgsaa.org. Please complete them and bring them to the October meeting. Barry will be calling the reps before this meeting to get a tentative count on the number of teams.

Please have your basketball meetings at the end of September. After October 18 any changes in the number of teams will cost \$100. After the schedule is complete, schools will be charged a league fee for any changes in the number of teams submitted.

Remember that the only game exception days are all-school, required functions.

The registration forms for the Mid Town Fall Classic basketball tournament will be mailed by September 20. The fee is \$100 per school if you register before Oct. 15.

## 7. Track

There was no report from the track commissioner.

## 8. New Business

There was a motion made to rescind the amendment to Rule 33 that was approved last year. Today the rule reads:

All CGSAA Official Basketball League Rosters are due at the December CGSAA meeting unless league games start prior to that date and then they are due 48 hours prior to the first official league game. **IT MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND SIGNED BY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.** Students can only play on 1 team and be on 1 roster.

Once a school submits their roster(s) at the December CGSAA meeting, no existing CGSAA school student(s) may be added to a team's roster after January 1st, of the current season. Player rosters will be locked after January 1st, for the current season and all CGSAA post-season tournaments. Schools with multiple teams, in grades 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>, will not be allowed to combine teams for all CGSAA Basketball post-season tournaments.

If a new student enrolls into a CGSAA school after the January 1st roster lock date, and he or she wants to play basketball, the new student can be added to the basketball roster for the appropriate grade with approval of the school principal.

It is proposed that the above amendment to Rule 33 be changed back to the original rule:

The CGSAA Official League Roster is due at the December CGSAA meeting unless league games start prior to that date and then they are due 48 hours prior to the first official league game. **IT MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY AND SIGNED BY THE SCHOOL PRINCIPAL.** Students can only play on 1 team and be on 1 roster. No existing school student may be added to a team's roster once the league season is 50% complete. This includes the remainder of league and Year-end Tournament games. Newly transferred students may be added to the rosters at any time with approval of school principal.

Please discuss the above change with your principals. We will vote on the change at the October meeting.
