

Out of Bounds Plays

Figure I

- Player 1 (your best passer) inbounds the ball. Player 3 stretches the defense and goes to the opposite corner. Players 4 and 5 set up on the ballside elbow, and Player 2 (best shooter) sets up on the opposite elbow.
- On the slap of the ball, Player 2 receives a double screen from 4 and 5 and looks to get a shot on the wing. After setting the screen, Player 4 pops to the top as a safety pass and Player 5 dives hard looking for a post up pass.

Figure II

- Box Set. Player 1 inbounds the ball, Player 5 on the ballside block, Player 4 on the opposite block, Player 3 on the ballside elbow, and Player 2 on the opposite elbow.
- On the slap of the ball, Player 5 sets a screen up for Player 3 and Player 4 then screens Player 5 bringing him to the opposite block for a layup – screening the screener.

Figure III

- Triangle Set. Player 1 inbounds the ball. Player 5 on the ballside block, Player 4 on the opposite block, Player 2 in the middle of the freethrow line, and Player 3 on the top of the key.
- On the slap of the ball, Player 5 cuts out to the 3-point line and Player 2 sets a screen for Player 3.
- The ball is inbounded to Player 5 and passed up to Player 3. (Figure IIIA)
- Player 1 now has the option of receiving a downscreen from either Player 5 *or* Player 4 and coming out on either side for a jump shot.
