

Concussion Law

The Minnesota Legislature Concussion Law requires online training for all coaches and officials, and concussion education for all parents and athletes. The Minnesota Concussion Law also requires any municipality, business, school district or nonprofit organization that organizes a youth athletic activity and charges a fee, to follow the statute's requirements. This includes implementing concussion training and education to improve player safety and establish safe return-to-play policies for athletes who sustain a concussion.

Below is a link to complete the required training. Please print the certificate and turn this into the board. You will not be named as a coach until completed.

Anyone who intends to volunteer as a coach or assistant coach is required to complete the concussion training program through the link below. You will be required to create a login and review the short program and answer a short quiz at the end of the program. Upon passing the quiz you will receive via email a certificate which is good for two years. Proof of certification will be required prior to the season and for all tournament entries.
