**3. Old Business**

There was no old business.

**4. PLACT**

The next meeting will be in January. Let Brittany know about any coaches that are doing a good job as well as those that need to do better.

**5. Soccer**

Soccer will be played at the Ione Branch of the YMCA for one more year. All information will be posted on the CGSAA.org website.

The number of teams from each school should be sent to Keiffer as soon as possible. He will also need to know if you have children that need a team. He will be setting the schedule over Labor Day weekend.

Because games won't start until September 12 and will end before the last weekend in October (only 7 weekends), teams could play more than one game a day.

We will need to increase the league fees this year due to an increase in the referee fees.

Team costs will be:

\$215 for Kindergarten  
\$275 for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>,  
\$280 for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>  
\$320 for 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>.

Soccer fees will be due at the October meeting. The forfeit fees for this year are: kindergarten-\$25, 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> - \$35 and 5<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>-\$50.

St. Philip Neri will not be able to take charge of the concession stand this year. Ask at your schools to see if there are any interested groups to take on this project. It can be a money maker for your athletic program.

The teams that play the last game on Sunday should help clean up the park.

Please ask all the coaches to bring a first aid kit to the soccer games. They also need to have their own ice or instant ice packs.

## 6. Volleyball

Diane will need all the volleyball forms by August 24 or 25. You can find these forms on the CGSAA website.

A tentative game schedule will be sent to the reps on August 28. Please do not share this schedule with the teams or parents. If you see a problem with any of your games let Diane know by August 29. She will revise the schedule and send out a final schedule after Labor Day.

Volleyball games will begin on the weekend of September 12 & 13 and continue until the end of October. The Bishop McGuinness Shamrock Tournament for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders is set for October 24 and 25. That is also the weekend of the sixth grade tournament at Mount St. Mary's and the 5<sup>th</sup> grade tournament at All Saints.

There is a Monte Cassino Tournament for 8<sup>th</sup> graders on Sept. 19 and one for 7<sup>th</sup> graders on Sept. 26. Please let Diane know if your team plans to attend the tournaments at Monte Cassino so she will not schedule a game for you in Oklahoma City on that date.

The girls will no longer rotate off the bench in 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade, but will substitute in and out. Coaches should make every effort to give all girls in these grades equal playing time. Please let Diane know if you need strategies to help all the girls play as evenly as possible.

There will no longer be co-ed teams. Diane will send out a contact number for a boys' league.

## 7. Basketball

Gabe would like schools to start checking on gym availability on Saturdays and Sundays from December 5 through March 6.

League games will start December 5 and the state tournament will be March 4, 5 and 6. The city tournament for fourth and fifth graders will be February 27 and 28.
