WELCOME TO SPORTS OF LEWISVILLE RAILROAD PARK

Opened in October 2009, Toyota of Lewisville Railroad Park was developed in one phase and is the largest single capital project in the history of Lewisville. The sprawling park features multiple soccer fields, a dog park, a dog park, three tennis courts, a 100-yard football practice field, a 100-yard football practice field, and is the regional Toyota Field.

The original Toyota Field (open only about one mile north of the park and the railroad track) was one of the first new sports facilities in the city of Lewisville. The stadium was built by the Lewisville Soccer Association and Toyota. The stadium of the park contains the deep seating of the local stadium, which is reminiscent of the stadium that carried the hopes of the original Toyota Field. Stadium was placed next to the stadium and football practice to pay tribute to the stadium. The park continues to play a key role in the life of the community and is a key part of the city's future and past.
