

## **OSHL EXECUTIVE BOARD 9/4/2024 SPECIAL MEETING MINUTES**

Attendance: Ken Enscoe, President; Rob Meigs, Vice President; Jim Dennis, Secretary; Amber Bussey, Treasurer

1. Meeting called to order @ 6:30 p.m.

2. The only agenda item for this Special Meeting was the creation and vote on a player district boundary for the Dublin Irish. The OSHL Policies and Procedures specifically provide that the sole authority to decide and change OSHL player district boundaries is the OSHL Executive Committee which consists of the elected officers who are the President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer.

3. After discussion, it was moved, seconded, and unanimously voted approved as follows:

**The OSHL Executive Board hereby creates an OSHL Player District Boundary for the Dublin Irish. The geographical portion of said boundary shall consist of the entire Dublin, Ohio City School District, including the city limits of Dublin, Ohio as well as any and all cities, townships, and unincorporated areas that are within the officially established Dublin, Ohio City School District, including but not limited to the Dublin Scioto, Dublin Coffman, and Dublin Jerome High Schools, as well as any and all private, parochial, and home schools located therein.**

**The player portion of the Dublin Irish OSHL Player District boundary shall be confined to Junior Varsity high school players, since Dublin Irish to date has only fielded an OSHL Junior Varsity Team. A Varsity player who resides within or attends a public, private, parochial, or home school within the above Dublin Irish geographical district boundary shall continue to be regarded as being within and part of the OSHL Hilliard Wildcats Player District boundary, provided that said player has actually attended the Hilliard Wildcats Varsity team tryouts, and has been offered, accepted, and then been officially, actually, and continuously rostered on the Hilliard Wildcats Varsity team.**

**The OSHL Hilliard Wildcats are specifically prohibited from rostering on its Junior Varsity or any non-varsity team or practice squad it may hereafter create any player who is not officially, actually, and continuously rostered on its Varsity team and who resides or attends a public, private, parochial, or home school within the Dublin City School District.**

**An OSHL Junior Varsity player who resides or attends a public, private, parochial, or home school within the Dublin City School District, may attend OSHL Hilliard Varsity team tryouts, but must return to and/or play for the OSHL Dublin Irish Junior Varsity team if not offered, accepted, officially, and continuously rostered as a player on the OSHL Hilliard Wildcats Varsity team, and is specifically prohibited from being rostered on, participating, practicing, and/or playing for the OSHL Hilliard Wildcats Junior Varsity, and/or any other OSHL Hilliard Wildcats non varsity team or practice squad.**

**This OSHL Dublin Irish Player District, as defined above, shall be prospectively effective as of September 4, 2024 and hereafter, and may only be changed or modified pursuant to the process set forth in the OSHL Policies and Procedures.**
