

Mulvane Wrestling Club

Conduct At Tournaments

Intent: The Mulvane Junior Wrestling Club exists to provide the youth of Mulvane and the surrounding community an opportunity to:

1. Learn the fundamentals of wrestling
2. Develop and promote sportsmanship
3. Provide an opportunity for wrestling competition
4. Promote the sport of wrestling in the Mulvane community

Therefore, everyone associated with MWC; including wrestlers, parents, family, and friends are expected to conduct themselves in a manner which furthers the purposes of the club.

Wrestlers-At all times while representing MWC, conduct yourself in a sportsmanlike manner. Do NOT question the call of an official or table worker. That is the responsibility of your coach. Displays of displeasure when losing or taunting when winning will not be tolerated. This reflects on the entire club. Every wrestler will willingly and properly shake hands with their opponent and his coach at the conclusion of the match, and then go directly to your coach.

Each violation will be evaluated, taking into account all circumstances such as previous incidents and severity of the violation. Under no circumstances will a wrestler receive more than one warning, however, depending on the circumstances, first time offenders may sit out the next tournament.

Second occurrence will be automatic suspension of the next tournament. If, after sitting out a tournament, another incident occurs, the wrestler may be dismissed from the club for the remainder of the season.

Parents and Others: Only wrestler and coaches are permitted in the wrestling area. Since the wrestling area is not always defined, parents and others are to stay in the stands. Cheering for your wrestler is expected. However, yelling instructions to the wrestler may distract or contradict instructions from their coach. Any questions concerning rules or score should be asked of the wrestler's coach after the conclusion of the match. Under no circumstances should a parent confront a referee or table worker.

Keep in mind at all times the purpose of the club. It is a fact that we will get incorrect calls that go against us. Just as we will have some that go our way. Your wrestler does not need an excuse if he loses. What is important is that they did their best.
