1. Minutes

The minutes of the August meeting were approved.

2. Treasurers Report

A copy of the treasurer's report was handed out.

Please mail all volleyball, soccer and PLACT fees to Mike Milligan at 3409 N.W. 46th Street, OK 73112. Volleyball is \$325 per team. Soccer is \$275 for Division 1 (grades 1 and 2), \$280 for Division 2 (grades 3 and 4), and \$320 for Divisions 3 and 4 (grade 5, 6, 7 and 8). The fee for kindergarten is \$215 per team. If these fees are combined into one check, please note how much for each sport and PLACT training.

If the person who receives the officials, scorekeeper and gym use money is different from last year, please send Mike the name and address of the new contact person at your school.

The treasurer's report was approved.

3. Unfinished Business

Two representatives from the Thunder spoke at the meeting about a basketball clinic they are offering to all CGSAA players. It will be a 45 minute clinic that samples the Thunder Youth Basketball Camps. For \$22 the children will be able to participate in the clinic, receive a camp t-shirt and a ticket to an OKC Blue game. The camp will be on Saturday, December 5th. Gabe will send out registration instructions and information about times as soon as they are available.

4. Soccer

Soccer games will start on September 13 and the schedule for these games is online.

The soccer season will continue through the weekend of Oct. 24.

Keiffer needs help setting up the fields, especially on the Thursday and Friday before the first games (Sept 10 and 11). He will be out at the fields by 4:00 each of those days. If you can help, please call him at 417-0804.

When you hand out the schedule, please also hand out a parking map. For the safety of children and access for any emergency vehicles, please ask parents to follow the parking map and not move cones.

Please ask your team members to stay away from the flags. Parents may sit on either side of the field. They may not sit behind the goals.

If there is a cancelation due to weather, a notice will be posted on the CGSAA website by 8:00 a.m. that morning.

Please remind families to clean up after their games.

Coaches need to bring a first aid kit and ice for injuries to every game.

Thank you to St. John Nepomuk School for taking over the concession stand. They will have drinks and snacks for everyone.

5. Volleyball

The volleyball games will begin the weekend of Sept 12.

Remember that the only game exception days are all-school, required functions.

The Tulsa tournament will be held on December 4, 5 and 6. The Doubletree Inn has once again given CGSAA teams a special room rate.

The Mid-Town Classic will be held the two weekends before Thanksgiving. There will be more information at the October meeting.

9. New Business

There are two new state laws and two mandates from the OSSA that will need to be addressed by the schools in our league. The laws deal with concussion management and sudden cardiac arrest awareness. The state mandates have to do with physicals for student athletes and coaches training for the care of concussions or sudden cardiac arrest.

The archdiocese will decide how these laws will be addressed in the schools.
