



2015/2016 Travel Basketball Player Fees

Fond du Lac Youth Basketball Club, Inc.

The Fond du Lac Youth Basketball Club has established a player fee of \$150.00 (\$100 player fee, \$50 fundraising) per participant in 5th – 8th grade and \$125.00 (\$75 player fee, \$50 fundraising) per participant in 3rd & 4th grade. The player fees will be used to offset some of the costs of our tournaments, uniforms, basketballs and other coaching supplies. These will be the only direct cost required from you this year other than your efforts in raising money through the tournaments our club will host.

In the past, families have done a great job of making our tournament successful. We encourage you to continue your support. On average, the player fees cover approximately 50% of each team's out of town tournament costs, with the FYBC paying the balance. These are additional fees that would normally be out of pocket expenses. The FYBC uses our home tournaments to raise money to help reduce the cost to you. In addition, the FYBC teams do not pay entry fees for any of our Fond du Lac tournaments. Also keep in mind that no one is being paid to coach or manage within this organization. It's strictly a volunteer job.

In order to make our tournaments a success and to raise enough funds to cover our expenses, volunteer hours will need to be worked. On average, you can expect to work about 4 hours per home tournament that your player is participating in. Work duties can include gate sales, concession or cleanup. Your team manager will set up all times available to work. The tournaments are the Club's biggest fund-raiser, and we cannot be successful without your help!

In addition to the player fee, each **participant** will be required to pay a \$150.00 deposit check (\$100.00 to cover the volunteer hours and \$ 50.00 to cover uniform replacement). If a players' volunteer hours are satisfied, and your uniform is returned cleaned, and in satisfactory condition at the end of the season, the check will be returned. If they have not, the check will be deposited to the Club's account. If you are unable to volunteer during the scheduled time during the tournaments, you are asked to work it out with your team parents by switching hours/tournaments. Volunteer hours are not optional. If a player fails to work the designated hours, the Club will reserve the right to adjust that players' fees the following season.

Please make separate checks (participation fee & deposit fee) out to **Fond du Lac Youth Basketball Club, Inc.** and bring it, along with all of your paperwork, to registration night in October. No uniforms will be handed out to any player unless their fee is paid in full.
