## PARENT/LEGAL GUARDIAN CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

As a parent/legal guardian of \_\_\_\_\_ (player) involved on the \_\_\_\_\_ (team) of **Ann Arbor A's Travel Baseball**, I agree to abide by and follow the rules and guidelines below.

- 1) I will promote the emotional and physical well-being of my son ahead of any personal desire to win.
- 2) I will remember that my son plays baseball for his enjoyment, not mine.
- 3) I will encourage good sportsmanship through my actions, by demonstrating positive support for all players.
- 4) I will provide support for coaches and officials working with the players to provide a positive experience for all. I will leave the coaching to the coach during the game. I will not give instructions during the game.
- 5) I will demand my son to treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with respect.
- 6) I will treat all players, coaches, officials, parents, and spectators with dignity and respect in language, attitude, behavior, and mannerisms.
- 7) I will cheer within the spirit of fair play and shall do my best to cheer the effort regardless of the outcome.
- 8) I will do my best to make sure that my son is on-time and prepared for every game and practice.

I understand that, by signing this document, I am agreeing to support and promote this Parent/Legal Guardian Code of Conduct Agreement. Further, my failure to comply with this Agreement or my participation in any of the defined CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE will result in disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion from **Ann Arbor A's Travel Baseball** and its affiliate member associations.

#### CONDUCT SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINE

*Examples of words or actions which will constitute a violation of the Code, include, but are not limited to the following:*

- 1) Making physical contact with any player, coach, official, league representative, field personnel, or spectator;
- 2) Taunting or threatening any player, coach, official, league representative, field personnel, or spectator;
- 3) Going into the dugout of an opposing team or obstructing their access to or exit from the dugout;
- 4) Going into the umpire's dressing area or obstructing their access to or exit from the field;
- 5) Using profane and/or vulgar language or mannerisms;
- 6) Going onto the baseball field;
- 7) Throwing of any object onto the field, into the player area(s), or at another individual;
- 8) Defacing or damaging property belonging to any individual, team, association, or field;
- 9) Being involved in any activity that would warrant the summoning of law enforcement officials;
- 10) Inciting any person(s) to become involved in any of the above-listed behaviors.
- 11) Any other conduct that is not in compliance with the tenets of the Ann Arbor A's Travel Baseball and its affiliate member organizations.
