To determine a first and second place team for the MEAHA State Tournament scheduled on March 4 – 2016 – March 6, 2016, The Central Division of MEAHA will hold a Round Robin Tournament to be played amongst its top 4 Bantam teams. Each team will play the other 3 teams. Games will be 3 – 12 minute stopped time periods with 1 hr. curfew. Points will be accrued as follows: Win =2 pts., Tie = 1 pt. Teams will be reseeded after the 3 games and the top 2 teams will advance to the Championships. If there is a tie in points, placement will be decided by the following criteria, in order:

- a. The first tie breaker is head to head competition.
- b. Second, total goals for less total goals against in head to head competition.
- c. Third, total goals for divided by total goals against in head to head competition. The team with the higher quotient will be the higher seeded team.
- d. Fourth, total goals for less total goals against in all tournament games.
- e. Fifth, total goals for divided by total goals against in tournament games. The team with the higher quotient will be the higher seeded team.
- f. Sixth, Coin toss

The Championship game will be played on Sunday February 28th. Games will not end in a tie. Both the Champion and Runner-Up teams will go on to the State Tournament the following weekend. The championship game will be played to determine 1st and 2nd place in the Central Division and for seeding purposes at the State Tournament

CREDENTIAL BOOKS

To facilitate the process of approving information for the Conference Tournament and MEAHA State Tournament all qualifying teams will present their information in a **THREE RING BINDER**, organized with divider tabs, referred to as the team's credentials book prior to the first game. All teams should provide 15 roster stickers for the game sheets prior to the beginning of the tournament.

ZERO TOLERANCE

The game will be stopped by game officials when parents/spectators displaying inappropriate and disruptive behavior interfere with other spectators or the game. The game officials will identify violators to the coaches for the purpose of removing parents/ spectators from the spectator's viewing and game area. Once removed, play will resume. Lost time will not be replaced and violators may be subject to further disciplinary action by the local governing body. This inappropriate and disruptive behavior shall include:

1. Use of obscene or vulgar language in a boisterous manner to anyone at any time.
2. Taunting of players, coaches, officials or other spectators by means of baiting, ridiculing, threat of physical violence or physical violence.
3. Throwing of any object in the spectators viewing area, players' bench, penalty box or on ice surface, directed in any manner as to create a safety hazard.
