- Ordered 20 pairs of skates for skate rentals for \$1,100, which will come out of the grant money that we were awarded.
- Programs are done. About the same amount of advertisers as last year which raised around \$4,000.
- We still need someone to help make some calls to help sell the ads for the radio. We need 8 sponsors to do \$450 per ad. Jeff Anderson, former "voice of the Lakers" may be doing senior night and meet the Lakers. He will be recognized for his years of service, awarded a plaque and given a season pass.
- A coach at the varsity level who is no longer showing up has now been removed. We have filled that position with Jason Good. Jamison Spiering has also offered to help out along with his Bantam duties.

Girls Varsity: D. Kunkel

- New jerseys are ordered and we're waiting for them to arrive
- One of the parents from the Quarter Back Club inquired about the hockey schedule. S. Sheehan will take care of that.

U12 Girls: K. Steen

- Season is off to a good start. Will be doing a big sister/littler sister program with the Girls Varsity.
- Have a couple new girls now up to 15.
- Found out that other teams were allowed to dual roster U12 girls and JV/Varsity. We will look at utilizing this option in the future.

Boys Varsity: C. Eide

- Tournament in Wisconsin changed location 30 miles. No real cost change.
- The breezer covers look and work great.
- Need to buy two good medical first aid kits through Midwest Medical. J. Sheehan will be taking care of that.

Squirts: K. Evans

- 24 squirts going to make 2 teams – 1 A and 1 B. The coaches would like to be able to let a few kids play both A & B. This was looked into but not possible as 20 is the max on a roster and kids cannot be dual rostered.
- We will be going to Brookings and Pierre for tournaments this year.
- We need a Park and Rec coordinator, as it is too much work along with the Squirt responsibilities.
- We also need an In-House coordinator for next season and a separate In-House registration form. Need to recruit at least two people to do this

Mites: A. Redlin

- 36 Kids and 1 A and 3 B Teams (9 Kids Per Team as it is cross ice).
- So far there are 35 In-House kids registered. Expecting a few more.
