Manager Reports

Vice President Football - The draft has been completed and it coaches can now contact their players.

It would be beneficial for the head coaches to discuss their choices for assistant coaches.

Practice coaches: Coaches perceive no problem with having them. It is actually beneficial to some of the coaches. If they aren't allowed practice coaches and they need assistance the people helping then have no training and have not had a background check. In the past it was limited to two practice coaches.

Commissioner – At the LCAJFL, Pinckney has proposed to have playoff games for all three levels. Problems with this include separate games at the end of the season for all three levels per color. This means that families that have children on multiple levels could be playing at different locations. This could increase the pressure that freshmen teams feel to win. Robert will vote no.

Lakeland wants to move a player down a level for a student that is being moving up in grade academically and is younger. This would be setting a precedent and Robert will vote no.

Our numbers for football are down and Robert will look into the reason why and send out an email.

Question on whether instructional football could be hurting freshmen numbers.

Vice President of Cheer: Tumbling starts the 26 of this month at infinity. Cost is 10 per week. 81 are enrolled in cheer.

Cheer Equipment: 79 girls were fitted at registration.

Registration Manager: There are approximately 24 kids on Varsity, 24 JV, 17 freshmen per color. We would like to keep instructional numbers are 15 per team.
