All outstanding bills are paid. We have \$47,062 in checking and \$22,942 in savings. We have made a net profit from concessions of \$2,200 from three home games and pantherfest. Football Equipment: Sean is waiting to hear from some of the teams about when their team parties are before setting a date for equipment return. Events Manager: We had 82 golfers, we made \$10,500 in profits. The buffalo wild wings fundraiser we made \$170. Yearbook ad forms have been sent out. East's homecoming is September 25th. We have been invited to join lineup starts at 5:30

Old Business: Non- profit status Carlo and Mike are still working on it.

New Business:

It was asked what the minimum number of players on a team is. The minimum number of players on a team should be 18. Panthers doesn't always meet that minimum on the freshmen teams. The board is aware that we don't always meet the minimum number and it was discussed after registration. Different options were looked at and we decided to proceed as usual for this season. It was asked if we had considered changing how kids were placed and maybe changing it to be the same as the school boundaries so that once the kids reached high school they would have been playing football together for all those years. It was pointed out that even if we changed it to the boundaries that the kids wouldn't be playing all together because we would still have multiple teams.

Lakeland Broncos have increased their gate fees to \$5. The league agreed a few years ago to cap their fee at \$4. The Lakeland broncos are charging \$4 to anyone wearing bronco spirit wear. This is being addressed by the league.

It was addressed that Facebook was not the place for people to request things from vendors that we have used. Two incidences have occurred where there were problems that needed to be addressed and those should have been addressed either with the vendor or information should have been sent to the board.
