- IV. Call to Public – none
 - a. Football – With loss of daylight, practices starting Tuesday, October 13 to:
 - Freshman: 5:15 – 7:00
 - JV: 5:30 – 7:15

5th grade camp for Sayer is week of October 5 – these are excused absences. Hardy is last week of October and will only affect a team if they are in the final game on October 31. Lakeland admission was capped at \$4.00 (they were trying to increase gate prices to \$5).
 - b. Cheer Pom – practice times were switched to accommodate coaches with some teams changing practices to Sunday. Cheer practices will match ending time for medics when schedule changes.
 - c. Treasury: \$43k in checking and \$22K in savings accounts. 2015 taxes are up to date so far. Still some issues with taxes and accounting from 2014. Working on 501c3 still. Gate is making the most money for our games, versus concessions and 50/50. 50/50 sales have been light.
 - d. Equipment – Sean wants to schedule the return date for Sunday, November 8 from 10:00 – 2:00. There will be an alternate date as well. Looking at asking for equipment deposits next year along with volunteering deposits.
 - e. Events – Yearbook ads have been turned in. We had 78 ads sold this year versus 104 last year so yearbooks will be smaller. Yearbooks should be ready for November 8 equipment turn in.
