Job Description			
<p>Role and Responsibilities</p> <p>As the name implies, on-rink officials do their job in the hockey rink. They are traditionally clad in a black hockey helmet, black trousers, and a black-and-white striped shirt. They also carry a finger whistle, which they use to stop play. They communicate with players, coaches, off-rink officials, both verbally and via hand signals.</p> <p>The GTIHL will have a two-official system. Each official is responsible for the general supervision of the game and (s)he can be identified by his/her black-and-white striped shirt. Both referees will have the authority to assess penalties for violations of the rules.</p> <p>In the two-official system, each official acts as both referee and linesman. Each official has the responsibility to call both penalties and line violations. In this system, neither official wears red or orange armbands. The two-official system is used at lower levels of youth hockey and in most adult recreational leagues.</p> <p>Officials have the responsibility of watching over the entire game. They make calls on penalties, signal goals and communicate with coaches and players.
