Re: Winter Report - 2016

CEP Clinics

We hosted 104 clinics this season and in the process certified 4,145 coaches. The clinic breakdown is as follows:

2015 Level 4 Clinics

This year we hosted two Level 4 clinics. We had a spring clinic in Rochester, and a fall clinic in Bloomington. There were 65 coaches in attendance for the Rochester clinic and 230 coaches at the Bloomington clinic. We were once again fortunate to have a great line up of presenters including: Dick Emahiser, Mike Gibbons, Hans Skulstad, Wes Bolin, Mike Taylor, Mike MacMillan, Ty Newberry, Steve Carroll, Guy Gosselin, and others.

Temporary Cards

The Temporary Card process has continued to work well, and Temp Card requests remain at the same level as last year. There have only been about 20 temp cards issued this season.

Last Chance Clinics

A series of "last chance" clinics were hosted in Bloomington on December 27. We hosted a Level 1, Level 2, and Level 3 clinic. The Level 2 and Level 3 had a good number of attendees. We ended up with 296 coaches in attendance for the Level 1, which is not conducive for our curriculum and clinic experience. We will be working to add a few more Level 1's in December to avoid such a large class.

Summary

Overall it was a very good year. The CEP staff continues to be committed to running a world-class education program. All clinics were closed out for the year by December 28th, and there have been fewer issues with coaches out of compliance than ever. Those are both attributed to a great staff!
