For Level 1 Certification and Level 2 Accreditation, all match officials must complete the following PRIOR to attending a Level 1 or 2 courses:

- a) Register with World Rugby Passport

- b) Completion of World Rugby Ready Program

All new and current match officials in must complete World Rugby Ready each year. No exceptions.

- c) Completion of World Rugby Laws of the Game Exam

Go to <http://laws.worldrugby.org/> and log in with your new World Rugby Passport. This will take you directly to the latest World Rugby Laws of the Game Exam.

- d) Completion of World Rugby Concussion Program

- a) Register with Rugby Canada
- b) Become a member of ERURS
- c) Complete a fitness test and receive a basic kit package (whistle, flags, cards)
- d) Actively participate in officiating
- e) Receive coaching reports (formal/informal)
- f) Keep up with current trends through scheduled Education Sessions
