



Goalie Equipment:

Recognizing the additional expense of outfitting goaltenders in the sport of hockey, the Woodstock Youth Hockey Association has adopted the following policy guideline with respect to goalie equipment.

The Association will provide suitable equipment, *if available for all teams*. It is the responsibility of the parent/player to contact the Equipment Manager to check the availability of goalie equipment.

The following is the amount of credit to be issued for goalie equipment purchases:

- **Initiation thru Mites** – the Association provides leg pads, blocker, catching glove and upper body gear.
- **Squirts** may receive up to 25% credit towards registration fees to purchase goalie equipment.
- **Pee Wees** and **Girls non-Varsity** may receive up to 50% credit towards registration fees to purchase goalie equipment.
- **Bantams** may receive up to 75% credit towards registration fees to purchase goalie equipment.

With the advice of the Equipment Manager, it is the responsibility of the Treasurer and President to approve all reimbursements or credits for goalie equipment purchased by a player with verification of receipts submitted to the Treasurer. It is the responsibility of the parent/player to check with the equipment manager prior to purchasing any equipment as to whether it will be covered under the reimbursement program. **Any and all equipment purchased and reimbursed to a player by Woodstock Youth Hockey Association will become the property of the Association and will be returned to the equipment manager at the end of each season.**
