## **Board Elections**

Four board spots are open. Toby, Sharon, Greg and Keith's spots are open. So far only two nominations have been handed in. Keith will stay on for one more 3 year term and Sharon has agreed to stay on one more year in her current role. Keith would like to start to train someone to take over the registrar duties. Toby suggested Bill Brew be nominated as President. Bill indicated that he will have to think this over before committing.

## **Mite Jamboree**

The Mite Jamboree will be hosted by SRI and held on 3/19/16 at Boss Arena. The fee will be \$200 per team and it is expected that there will be 10 teams. SRI will get \$2,000 from the State League to supplement the cost of the ice. Each team will play a total of 4 games over 2 days. Games will be based on 25 min running time periods. All players will receive a t-shirt and medal/trophy. There will be a food truck selling coffee and food items outside in the rink parking lot. Approval has been granted by rink management and URI for the truck to be located in parking lot. We will need volunteers to check kids in and run clock. It is expected that there will be approximately 160 kids participating. Courtney indicated that she has lined up about 15 parents to help. We will get older kids to help run clock.

## **Travel Tryouts**

Travel tryouts for Squirrels, Peewees, and Bantams will 3/22, 23, 24 2016. It will be held from 6-9pm. We will need 4 people on ice and several evaluators. Evaluators will include Jack McGreen, Mike Mulvey, Joe Gately and possibly Pete Chabot and Dino Rizzo. The date to pick the teams will be Tuesday 3/29/16 and Bill Brew will contact the Carriage Inn to see if we can get a large room to accommodate us.

**Girls Panthers/SRI Program:**

Todd has been handling the rollout of a formal Panthers/SRI co-op U14 and U16/19 program. However, NEGHL indicated that we could not skate in their program unless we field 3 teams. Therefore, we will not be able to skate in the NEGHL in the 2016-17 season. Instead Todd will offer a developmental league.

**Other business:**

SNEHC indicated that there might not be a ½ season for Bantams next fall. Instead there will be a full season with an A, B and C team levels.

Tuition will remain the same for travel teams at \$1,030 for a full season/ we will require \$100 tryout fee and \$150 fee to hold spot on team.

Jack McGreen indicated that there is approximately \$80,000 in the bank account.

SRI will conduct a year end survey once again this season.
