

DSTHL Video Review Policy

The League is entering into a trial period of utilizing video review specifically and solely as a means to determine whether or not an on-ice action caught on video is deserving of a formal review process for potential supplemental discipline. The League will not use video review for the purpose of changing any on-ice call whatsoever as USAH rules prohibit any on-ice call from being changed once the game is over.

The following process shall be followed:

- Each Association POC or Director of Hockey should first review the video to determine if the actions warrant submission to the League.
- The League will accept videos submitted only by the Association POC or Director of Hockey.
- Upon receipt by the League, the video will be initially reviewed by a member of Hockey Operations Board ("HOB") and President to determine if the video warrants further review.
- If further review is deemed advisable, a review process will be undertaken by a Video Review Committee (the "VR Committee") comprised of three (3) independent / non-associated members of the HOB.
- The DSTHL President will not participate in the review but will oversee the VR Committee.
- If the VR Committee determines that the player(s) or Coach(s) actions warrant supplementary discipline, the HOB or League President will reach out to the Association's POC or Director of Hockey to advise of the VR Committee's recommendation.
- Any supplemental discipline imposed will be at the discretion of the Member Association, and it will
 be the responsibility of that Association to implement and enforce any such discipline. Neither the
 League nor the VR Committee will be responsible for imposing or enforcing supplemental discipline.
- If, for any reason, the video is escalated to TAHA, the League review process will be dropped and the League will adhere to recommendations by TAHA.
