SlugFest Rules

- Slugfest is available for ALL Central Perk players in ALL divisions.
- Team Coaches will pitch to their respective players.
- Balls will be scored where they hit the ground for Baseball Majors, Baseball Minors, Connie Mac, Softball Majors & Softball Seniors, not where they stop rolling!!
- T-Ball, Pony, Baseball Rookie, Softball Rookie & Softball Minors divisions will be scored (including bulls-eyes) where the batted ball stops rolling for higher scores. Example: if a hit ball rolls into a bulls-eye, then the batter will receive the bulls-eye points.
- T-Ball & Pony Divisions will have additional Bulls-eyes for more chances of scoring points!!!!
- A Bulls-eye **MUST BE HIT IN THE AIR** before hitting the ground to be counted for batters points. (Except where noted above)
- The 'green' part of the bulls-eyes are considered part of the bulls-eye, the bulls-eye point will be awarded in ALL divisions.
- 'L' Screens being used on any field will be considered as an "Infield Bulls-eye" points
- Each player is scored on 12 swings.
- A swing and a miss count as 1 swing.
- Foul balls count as 1 swing.
- All balls must be fair balls to score.
- The poles of each of the scoreboards are considered part of the scoreboard and will be awarded scoreboard points.
- If you are not able to bat during your teams allotted time slot, you will be able to hit during another teams time after that team has batted. Every effort will be made for all players who signed for SlugFest will get their chance to bat during their divisions allotted hitting time on their divisions field.
- The top five individual scores for each division will compete at the finals
- Each field will have the top 5 scores posted, and will be updated throughout the day
- If you are one of the top 5 scorers for you division, you **MUST** be present to compete during the scheduled finals time for that division, no exception will be made.
- Each division will be using the same balls use for regular season games.
- Only Central Perk/Cal Ripken approved bats are to be used (see CP website)
- Any hitter/coach using or attempting to use illegal balls or bats will be disqualified and the player scores will not be counted.
- Any hitter/coach breaking or attempting to break any SlugFest rule will be disqualified

(All Divisions)

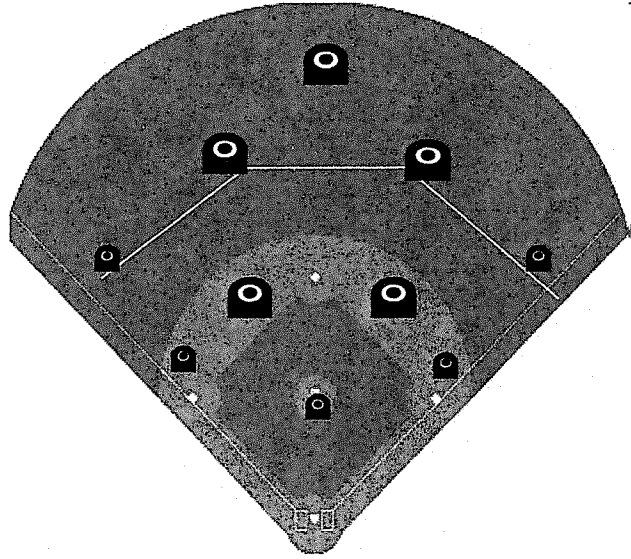
In the event more than one batter has the same number of points, the Tiebreakers will be applied as follows...

Number of Hits (Not Points) for each Tie-Breaker

- 1st – Greater number of **TOTAL** fair hits
- 2nd – Number of Home Runs
- 3rd – Number of Outfield Grass Hits – Outer Field Grass – (Non-Bulls-Eyes)
- 4th – Number of Outfield Grass Hits – Inner Field Grass – (Non-Bulls-Eyes)
- 5th – Number of Outfield Bulls-Eyes
- 6th – Number of Infield Hits – Non Bulls-Eyes (grass/dirt combined)
- 7th – Number of Infield Bulls-Eyes
- 8th – Coin Flip!!! Best of 5 Tosses
