



Green Bay Eastside Baseball

Majors (11/12)

1. All games will be six innings, with time limit of 1 hour and 30 minutes. Clock should be set to 80 minutes. No inning will start after 80 minutes. A new inning is defined as having started when the final out to end the previous inning is recorded
2. 10 run rule after 4 innings, 3 ½ innings if the Home Team is winning
3. 50' mound - 70' bases.
4. Only USA stamped bats will be allowed. Bats can be 2 ¼" or 2 5/8" in diameter.
5. All teams must roster bat, however only play nine in the field. Teams playing with 9 fielders must play with 3 outfielders. Outfielders must be on the grass.
6. You must have eight players to start game. Players coming late will be added to the end of the batting order.
7. Dropped third strike - Batter may run on a dropped third strike.
8. Balks will be called. Each pitcher will be given a warning on the first balk.
9. Infield fly rule is in effect.
10. Stealing all bases is allowed. Runners may lead off. Delayed stealing is NOT permitted. Players MUST slide into all bases, except 1st base, if a play is being made. Sliding feet first is required with the exception of sliding back into a base on a pickoff attempt. It is the umpire's decision to rule the runner out if the player should have slid and failed to do so.
11. Free substitution will be used throughout the game for every position other than the pitching position. (must abide by Rule 12)
12. Once pitcher is removed from the pitcher's position, they may not re-enter the game and pitch again.
13. Hit-By-Pitch: If a single pitcher hits 3 batters, he must be replaced by another pitcher. The HBP does not have to occur in the same inning.
14. Coach's second trip to the mound for the same pitcher MUST result in change of pitcher.
15. Five warm-up pitches between innings and between pitchers.
16. No throwing around the horn.

17. Fake bunting is allowed. However, fake bunting and then swinging away is NOT allowed and the batter will be called out. No warnings will be given.
18. Courtesy runner for the catcher MUST be used with 2 outs, but maybe used at any time to enhance pace of play. Courtesy runner would be last out recorded in that inning.
19. Home Team gets the 3rd base dugout. Visitor Team gets the first base dugout.
20. Please have players hustle on and off the field.
21. Please have your team clean the dugout after each game (i.e. water bottles, gum wrappers, etc.).
22. Our umpires are paid for their service, however be respectful of their efforts. Coaches are responsible for player, parent and fan behavior.
23. Player/Coach unsportsmanlike conduct is subject to ejection from the game (and future games) upon the umpire's discretion. Parent unsportsmanlike conduct is subject to ejection from the park.
24. All participants and spectators will abide AT ALL TIMES by City of Green Bay Department of Parks rules and regulations regarding behavior and conduct.
25. Straight stealing home is NOT allowed. However, if a play is made at another base, or at 3rd base, the runner from third may advance to home.

Pitch Count Rules (11-12 Year Olds – Major League)

Any player who will be 11 as of 4/30/20 is considered an 11 year old (younger group), even if they are still 10 during the fall season

Any player who will be 12 or older as of 4/30/20 is considered part of the older group

Minimum combined 3 outs or 40 pitches from the younger group of players

All pitchers are limited to a maximum of 6 outs per game and 9 outs per calendar week.

All pitchers are limited to a maximum of 40 pitches per game and 60 pitches per calendar week.

A pitcher may finish a batter even it results in going over 40 pitches, however those pitches count towards the weekly total and the days of rest required.

Days of rest required:

0-20 pitches thrown: 0 days rest

21-40 pitches thrown: 1 day rest

41+ pitches thrown: 2 days rest
