



# 2018-2019 SELECT PLAYER/PARENT AGREEMENT

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## AUSTIN TEXANS SC WILL:

1. Adhere to the Texans Club Curriculum.
2. Provide professional training for the duration of the 2018-2019 seasonal year beginning with a Select Team Camp in August through early December for Fall and beginning again late January through the end of the Spring season in May (or later if team qualifies for post-season playoffs).
3. Offer optional playing and training activities (at additional cost) during the off season.
4. Foster and develop players' individual skills and character on and off the field.
5. Develop and assess the skills and qualifications of each coach.

## AUSTIN TEXANS SC COACH WILL:

1. Adhere to the Texans Club Curriculum.
2. Make all playing time decisions in accordance with current League rules.
3. Be responsible for training session curriculum and game line ups.
4. Communicate with the team's manager regarding team related business/issues that may arise affecting the team.
5. Be responsible for calling and presiding over team meetings.
6. Be on time for all meetings, training sessions and games.
7. Communicate team goals and progress with team families during the season.
8. Communicate individual player progress and development to the individual player and their family during the season.

## THE AUSTIN TEXANS SC PLAYER WILL:

1. Adhere to the Texans Club Curriculum.
2. Complete the on-line registration process. ([www.austintexanssc.com](http://www.austintexanssc.com))
3. Attend all scheduled training sessions and games.
4. Communicate to team's coach ahead of time absences due to illness, family functions, or school activities and arrange to makeup missed training sessions.
5. Report to games and training on time, dressed in Club uniform, shin guards and soccer shoes. Players must also bring their soccer ball and sufficient water to games.
6. Be attentive, cooperative and respectful to coaches, officials, and teammates and expend full effort for the duration of training sessions and games.
7. Avoid use alcohol, tobacco or drugs.
8. Strive to conduct himself/herself in a manner to avoid yellow and red cards.
9. Communicate with their coach about questions or concerns relative to their participation in the team or the team itself.

## THE AUSTIN TEXANS SC PARENT WILL:

1. Adhere to the Texans Club Curriculum.
2. Assist the development of players' individual decision-making abilities without offering instructions from the sidelines during training and games.
3. Support their player in a positive manner.
4. Entrust soccer decisions to the coaches.
5. Assist player's timely arrival to training sessions, games, and tournaments.
6. Refrain from interfering once their player has joined the team's soccer activity until the coach dismisses the team.
7. Be supportive and respectful spectators of all teams, all players and their supporters and all officials.
8. Allow the coach or club official to handle all communications with referees, non-Texans coaches, officials, representatives, etc. during and after all matches.



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9. Volunteer in some capacity, 5 hours minimum required per player. The club will assess a \$50 Volunteer Fee for each player at registration which is refundable at the rate of \$10 per hour for hours volunteered through the end of Fall and Spring seasons. Players may also contribute their time toward required volunteer hours.
10. Pay all fees for services in the specified timeframes as agreed to in the online Payment Agreement. Payments shall be credited first to overdue accounts, then to return check fees, and the remainder to current fees and charges.
11. Observe the game from the designated sideline area as determined by applicable rules.
12. Avoid use alcohol, other intoxicants, or tobacco during training sessions or games.
13. Participate; if deemed necessary in the an ATSC D&P Hearing with a committee appointed by the Board to determine if a parent was in violation of the above "Role of the Parent." If a parent is found in violation, suspensions or other disciplinary action may be incurred.

### **2018-2019 PLAYER FEES**

Player Fees are dependent on the team's play level.

Player Fees for the 2018-2019 Season will be as follows for **U12-U20**:

Premier/US Club TCL - \$2150.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

SCL/USC-CL/USC-W - \$2,000.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

Alpha / Prime / Challenger WDDOA - \$1,825.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

Division II - \$1,200.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

Player Fees for the 2018-2019 Season will be as follows for **U11**:

USC-W / Alpha / Prime / Challenger WDDOA - \$1,600.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

Division II - \$1,200.00, including fundraising fee + \$50.00 refundable volunteer buyout

Payment plans are available with player's online registration.

An initial **minimum Commitment Fee of \$350.00 is due upon registration** (acceptance onto a team). The **\$350.00 includes: \$50.00 Volunteer Buyout Fee + \$50.00 PP Setup Fee + \$250.00 toward Player/Training Fees**. If the player chooses to pay in full upon initial registration, then the \$50.00 PP Setup Fee is waived.

### **LATE PAYMENT POLICY: 15 DAYS LATE – FINAL WARNING; 30 DAYS LATE: NO PRACTICE, NO PLAY**

#### **ADDITIONAL TEAM EXPENSES & INVITATIONAL TOURNAMENTS**

Teams will incur expenses in addition to player fees for items/events such as \*Invitational Tournaments, Coach's travel expenses, camps, parties, and other activities specific to a particular team. The amount of these additional expenses will vary by team. The team's Manager or Treasurer will estimate additional team expenses and collect payments from team members equally during the season. If a team elects to participate in a "team event" such as an invitational tournament, all team members are expected to contribute equally to the expense of the event as it is considered a "team" expense – this applies even if an individual player is unable to participate.

\*Invitational Tournaments are non-season tournaments. Participation will be decided by the Coach and team.

### **VOLUNTEERING**

The Austin Texans Soccer Club is a non-profit organization operated by **volunteers like you**. Each Texans family upon player acceptance is committed to volunteer a minimum of **5 hours per player**. Multiple opportunities to volunteer are available: examples include but are not limited to, Board Members, Team Managers, Tournament Volunteers, Fundraising Coordinators, Picture Coordinators, Tryout Volunteers, and many more. **Each player will be assessed a \$50**

**Volunteer Fee upon initial registration.** After completion of required volunteer hours, \$10 per hour volunteered will be refunded to the player as follows:



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Money will first be applied to any past due balance. If no past due balance exists, Parent will be given the opportunity to apply it to a future fee payment OR Parent will be given the opportunity to apply it to player's team account or to receive check from the club

Completion of volunteer hours must be verified prior to any refunds applied or distributed. Refunds will not be processed until required volunteer hours have been completed. Refunds are generally processed at the conclusion of the Fall or Spring seasons. Any player who chooses to leave the club at any point during the year prior to end of spring season, will forfeit their \$50 Volunteer Fee to the club.

### FUNDRAISING

Beginning with the 2017-2018, the Austin Texans began adding fundraising fee into the training fees directly, thus allowing the option to spread them across the payment schedules or pay in full.

### UNIFORMS

Game and practice uniforms are required for every player. All player uniform orders will be coordinated through the Team Managers and Club Uniform Coordinator. Uniform costs are **EXCLUDED** in the Player Fees. Purchase of required uniform is an additional expense that is the responsibility of the player. Uniform pieces listed are subject to change.

#### GAME UNIFORM KITS –

1 Red Nike Game Jersey, 1 White Nike Game Jersey, 1 Red Nike Game Short, 1 Black Nike Game Short, 1 Red Nike Game Sock, 1 Black Nike Game Sock, 1 Nike Gold Pre-Game Jersey, & Nike Backpack. Logo & #'s are included. Long Sleeve Jersey is team optional.

Note: Black Nike Short is the same short as required for field players, purchase of only one is required.

I acknowledge that there are league or association rules governing the mid-season release from a club.

- USC (US Club Soccer Association) rule states that players are bound to a club for the duration of the soccer season as defined by USC's Competition Rules as "USC Season" and outlined in Section 1.6. "A USC Registered Player may not play for more than one USC Club during the USC Season, unless: the Director of Coaching of both the prior USC Club and the proposed new USC Club consent to the transfer in writing; the new USC Club has an available spot on a USC Roster and; the USC B.O.D consents to such transfer in writing."
- STYSA/WDDOA/CAYSA (US Youth Soccer) rules state "Any player rostered to a Primary team or Academy Program is bound to the team to which he / she is first rostered from August 1 until July 31 unless the player requests and obtains a release."
