2016 WY ASA State Tournament Rules

CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT RULES ASA codes and playing rules will apply as outlined in the current official guide with the following exceptions:

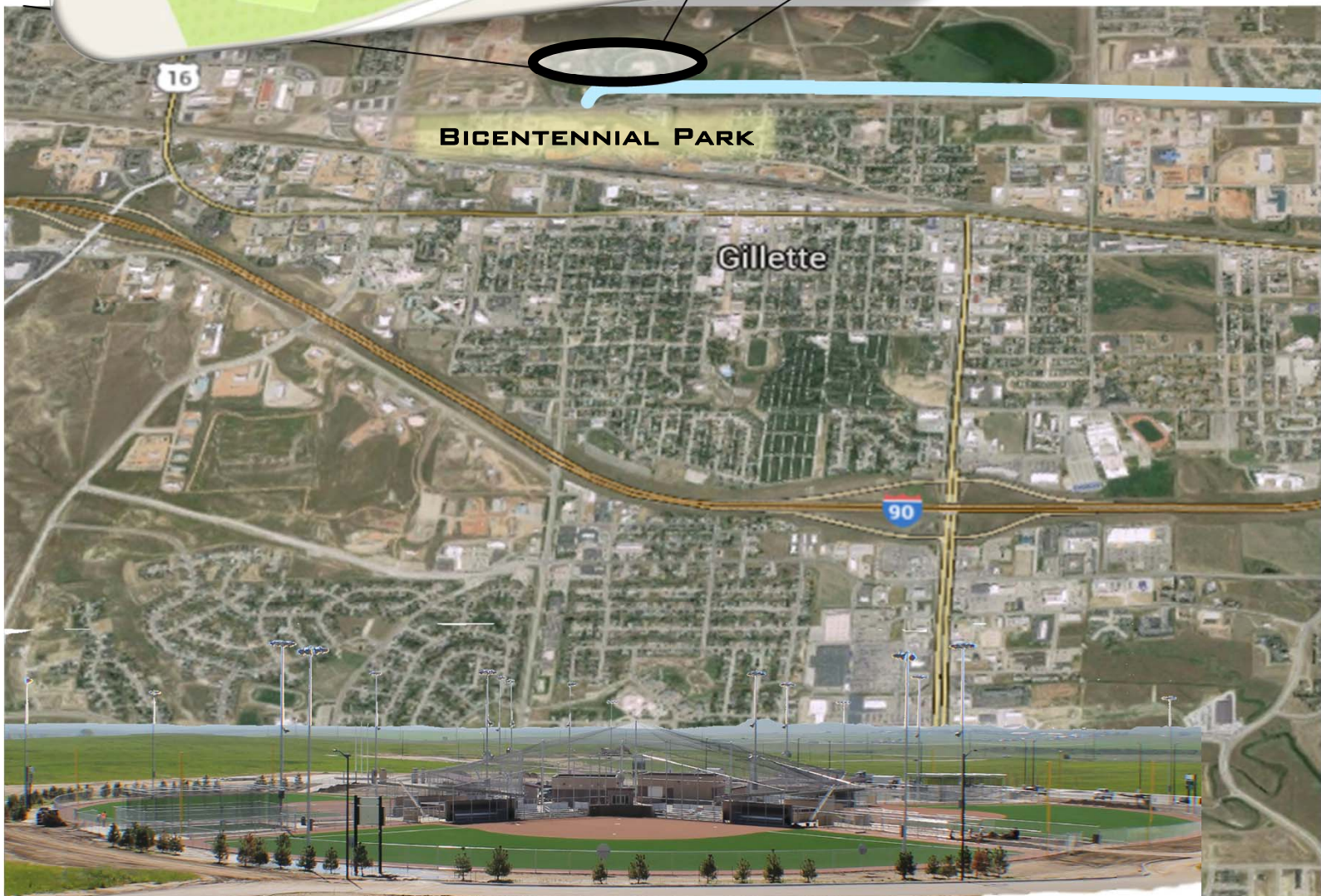
1. State Championship Tournaments will be double elimination. ASA rules will be enforced. You may bat your entire line up, and use free substitutions on Pool Play ONLY.
2. Championship Rosters need to be finalized by July 4th, 2016. Coaches need to check their teams in at the coaches meeting, no check ins after 6 pm on Thurs. July 7th.
3. *Player uniform requirements shall be enforced as listed in the ASA Code, every player, coach, or parent in the dugout must be background checked, at least 1 coach must be ACE Certified. **Coaches and parents in the dugout must have background check and/or ACE card on a lanyard visible at all times.***
4. Teams must check in with an ASA official 15 minutes prior to scheduled game time.
5. Game time is forfeit time. No grace period.
6. If tournament schedule is delayed, it shall be the responsibility of each manager to contact the ASA representative for possible game time and field location changes.
7. The team listed on top of the bracket shall occupy the third base dugout. Exception: A team playing in double header on the same field shall stay in the same dugout.
8. Home team shall be determined by a coin toss, at the time line-up cards are submitted. All equipment must be out and accessible for the Umpires to inspect before each game. Altered or illegal equipment being used in game play, will result in the Manager and player involved being ejected from the Tournament.
9. Game balls will be supplied by the tournament officials and are the only ball allowed in the tournament. If violated, the pitcher and head coach will be disqualified from the game per Rule 1 of Definitions. If the violation occurs again, the team at fault will forfeit the game.
10. Infield practice is not allowed, practice behind fences or in outfield is acceptable.
11. Playing rule protests will be settled prior to the next pitch. Player eligibility protests shall be made in a timely manner and according to ASA Code and tournament ground rule.
12. A Run Rule shall be in effect according to ASA, 15, 12, 8, after 3, 4, 5.
13. The Tie Breaker Rule shall be in effect according to ASA guidelines.
14. Time Limit Rule shall be in effect, 75-minute time limit, finish the inning. Championship games will be 7 innings or run rule. Except in the 10U division, it will be 90 minutes, run rule, or 7 innings.
15. Use of tobacco products is prohibited at Junior Olympic Tournaments. **NO GUM OR SUN FLOWER SEEDS ALLOWED INSIDE THE ENERGY SPORTS COMPLEX.**
16. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs are permitted on or near the fields, including bleachers and spectator areas.
17. Umpires (during games) and/or tournament officials shall have the responsibility of ejecting coaches, players, or spectators for abusive language or other acts that are contrary to the objectives and purposes of ASA. A warning for the first offense MAY be issued at the umpire's/officials discretion. The second offense by coaches or players shall result in ejection of the responsible individual(s) from the game. Second, and subsequent, offenses by a spectator shall result in ejection of the (1) head coach, (2) coaching staff, (3) players.
18. **10u Rec only – each team will bat 9 batters or 3 outs per half inning, whichever comes first. Batting line up will resume where ever it left off. There will be NO run rule per inning. All other rules remain the same.**

WELCOME TO GILLETTE

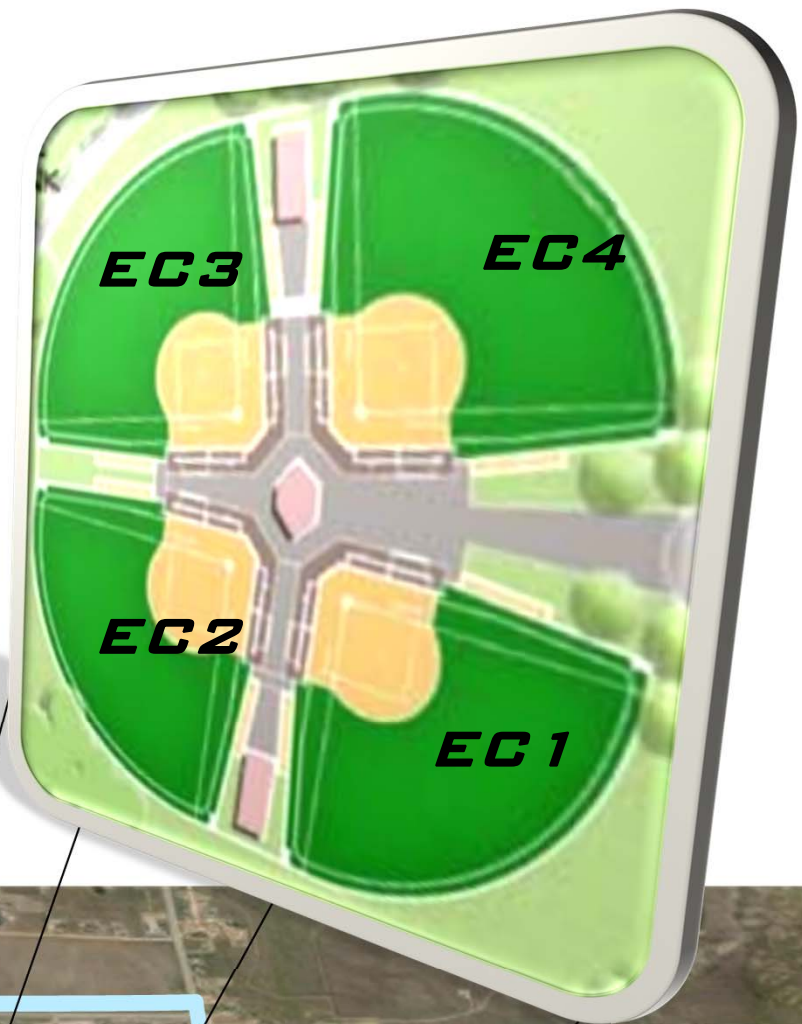


This tournament is being held at both Biccennial Park and the new Energy Capital Sports Complex. The two inset maps show the field layouts at the two facilities.

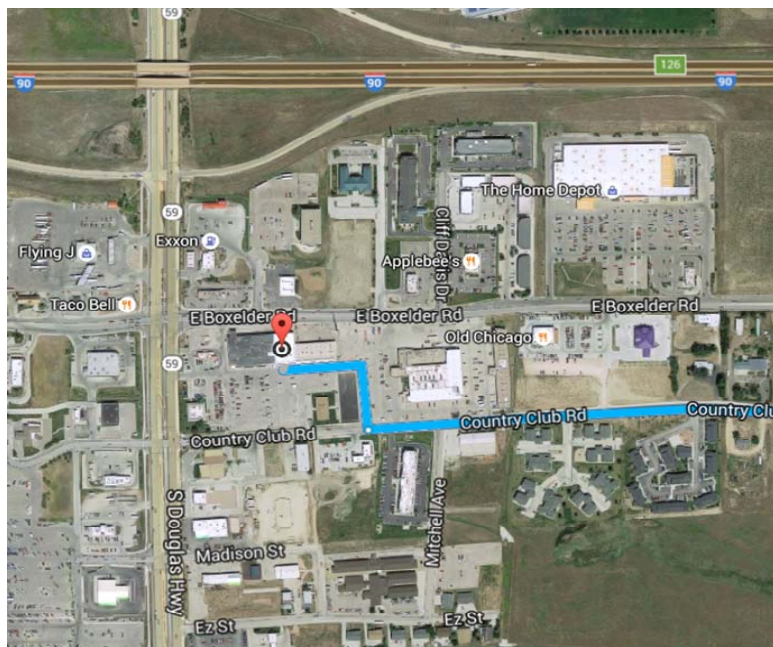
