New Business:

1. Stephanie Liddle does impact testing for concussions. She is a Physical Therapist and has done management with concussions as an athletic trainer. Her advice:
 - a. Coaches should document more than once to see a change.
 - b. When in doubt, sit them out. Symptoms may not show for 24 hours, so keep an athlete off ice.
 - c. Often, the symptoms or issues are hidden and not picked up by an IMPACT test
 - d. Common pitfalls could be
 - a. Relying on loss of consciousness to make a decision
 - b. No helmet ever prevents a concussion
 - c. The younger the athlete means longer time of recovery
 - d. BESS testing would be a great test to catch extra
 - e. More than a headache should be sent to a doctor or a PT with concussion training. Ask coaches for the info for Ms. Liddle
