## I. Programs

Heart of the Valley (HOV) is for girls in grades 3-6 and is a league that introduces team play with the emphasis on individual development and is less competitive. No girls will be cut and if a grade fields more than one team, the players will be split equally. All players will have equal playing time to the best of the coach's ability. HOV games will take place on the first two Saturdays in November and the first Saturday in December. Teams will travel to a school within the Valley area and play approximately three games each week. This program is only available to girls in the public school system and home schooled students, however, exceptions will be made if there is no team available at a parochial school. Practices for the HOV season will begin in October.

<u>Traveling Tournament Team</u> provides competitive play for girls in grades 3-8. This program focuses on both team and individual development. Tournament teams will play in weekend tournaments in and around Northeast Wisconsin. The number of tournaments will be determined by grade level. Practices for the tournament season will begin any time between October – December, based on grade level.

#### **II. Volunteer Requirements**

#### Option 1 – Volunteer Your Time

The NLGYBA sponsors numerous tournaments throughout the season (one Heart of the Valley tournament and one home tournament for each grade's traveling team). These tournaments are a one or two-day event, taking place on Saturday and/or Sunday. If this option is chosen, your family is expected to sign up for either concessions, admission at the door, set-up, clean up, keeping score, or keeping the clock at as many tournaments as your child competes in. (Ex: Your daughter plays HOV and is on the traveling team. You would be expected to volunteer at two tournaments throughout the season). As the tournaments near, volunteer sign-up will occur on a first-come, first-served basis via online registration. Total amount of volunteer time will not exceed 8 hours for the season.

### Option 2 – Payment Buy Out

If you are unable to volunteer your time at our home tournaments, a payment of \$150 can be made to the NLGYBA. This money will go to pay members from another organization (TBD based on date and availability) to assist in the tournament duties stated above. This payment is due at registration.

#### III. Uniforms

All girls participating in the NLGYBA will need a uniform. The same uniform is used for HOV and Traveling Tournament Teams. All grade levels will wear the same uniform, therefore, athletes can utilize the same jersey and shorts year after year, size permitting. Uniforms should be ordered directly from Fox Cities Embroidery (251 E. Main Street in Hortonville/920-779-9560) by October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2016 (There will be a \$20 additional late fee charged by Fox Cities Embroidery if not ordered by October 15<sup>th</sup>). The cost is approximately \$56/uniform and must be paid when ordered.

\*\*Although not required, we strongly encourage all parents of participants to get involved as much as possible in the NLGYBA. It would be great if every family could attend at least one monthly meeting.
