Where do I start? Take 30 minutes...Homework!!

- 1. Print off the retailer list: https://www.shopwithscrip.com/Shop/Product/BrandAlphabeticalList
- 2. Highlight the retailers you normally shop
- 3. Familiarize yourself with the Card types they offer.
 - a. \$xx Physical Gift Card Circle those that only offer physical cards
 - b. S ScripNow eCard
 - c. R Reload gift card Place a square around those that offer Reload (but not ScripNow) and a Star
 - d. RN ReloadNow gift card **Place a square around** those that offer ReloadNow (but not ScripNow)
- 4. Ordering how/what:
 - a. Circled Retailers: you will need order these before Wednesday 9pm on order weeks (i.e. Dick's Sporting Goods)
 - b. Squared retailers with a Star: If you have not already purchased a card for these, you will need to plan ahead and order them during our Wednesday order week. Once you have them, register them (including pin#) on the website, then remember these need to reloaded one business day before you need the funds. (i.e. Crazy 8). See below on Registering Reloadable Physical Gift Cards.
 - c. Squared retailers without a star f you have not already purchased a card for these, you will need to plan ahead and order them during our Wednesday order week. Once you have them, register them (including pin#) on the website, then reload them within 10-15 minutes of needed the funds. (i.e. Albertsons, Tom Thumb/Safeway). **

 Note ** consider having multiple gift cards for family members so you don't have to swap cards. See below on Registering Reloadable Physical Gift Cards.
 - d. **Retailers with no circle or square** you can order any time and they will be available within 10-15 minutes. (Home Depot can take up to an hour).

TAV will order physical gift cards every other week (odd numbered weeks on the 52 week calendar)

- 1. Go to https://shop.shopwithscrip.com/Login
- 2. Click "Sign In", and enter your Username and Password, and click "Sign In"
- 3. Click on "Shop" to view the retailers
- 4. Click on the Search magnifying glass and type the retailer name (i.e. CVS Pharmacy) and select it
 - CVS Pharmacy page is displayed, along with the type of giftcard offered CVS offers three different giftcard options



- Physical Gift Card Select your denomination and quantity of cards
- o ScripNow eCard Enter your dollar amount
- o ReloadNow (must purchase card first thru this program) Select the Card you want to reload and the dollar amount
- o Click "Add to Cart".

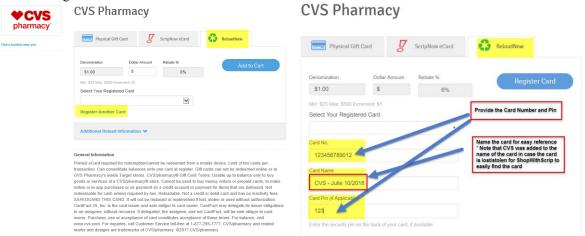
- 5. Repeat step 4 for all your gift card needs.
- 6. Once you are ready to check out, Click on the "Cart" at the top right of the screen
- 7. Verify your Order to be sure the cost looks right. Choose "Presto Pay", enter your "Pin", and click "Submit Order"

8. **Physical Gift card orders should be placed by 9pm on Wednesday's** (We currently order every other week on odd # weeks in the 52 week calendar i.e. 10/10/18 is the 41st week in the year), and cards will be delivered no later than the following Wednesday to the TAV location noted in your last name.

- 1. First, purchase a physical gift card thru this program
- 2. Once received, log back into https://shop.shopwithscrip.com/Login
- 3. Search for that retailer
- 4. Click on the Reload/ReloadNow tab
- Click on "register another card"



- a. Enter in the Card Number
- b. When naming the card, please be sure to add the retailer name in front of the name you choose as this allows the SWS helpdesk to assist you better if you have any questions on your card (i.e CVS Julie 12/2015)
- c. It is best to provide the Pin if there is one, which will help you if you ever lose your card, without it you cannot get the card replaced
- d. Click "register card"
- 6. The card is now ready to Reload/ReloadNow.
 - * Please be sure to keep a small balance on the card at all times. They will deactivate cards with a \$0 balance after 30 days
 - * If you have multiple Scrip Accounts (i.e. different username/bank accounts), Reload/ReloadNow cards can only be registered under one account (you would need to order multiple cards and register one for each account).

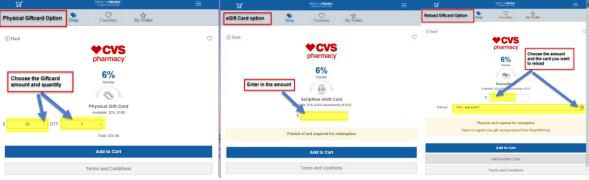

- 1. Log into: www.myscripwallet.com (you can create an Icon shortcut for your phone instructions further down)
- 2. Select Sign In
- 3. Enter in your Username and Password you created with the ShopWithScrip site (click remember me to save your Userid for the next time you sign in), and click Sign In

- 5. Choose the type of giftcard you want to purchase, enter the amount you want to purchase based on the type of giftcard chosen



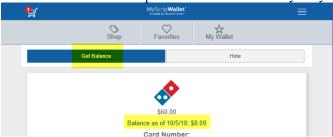

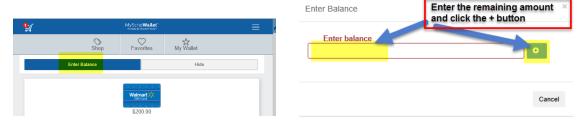
- 9. Availability of funds on Reload and/or eGiftcards:
 - a. Reload will be available the next business day if ordered Mon-Fri by 2:30pm
 - b. ReloadNow will be available within minutes
 - c. ScripNow eGift Card will be available within 5-15
 - * Some ScripNow retailers may take longer for the ScripNow to be available (i.e. Home Depot up to 1 hour)
 - * Some ScripNow retailers require you to print the eGift card (i.e. Macy's), however, most you can just provide the card number (i.e. restaurants) or show the barcode (i.e. CVS or Walmart)
 - * Be sure your screen brightness is high enough for the scanner to scan the barcode this is most likely the culprit if it is not scanning
 - ** Click on My Wallet to view available ScripNow eGift Card and Reload/ReloadNow retailers and balances

ScripNow eCards/Reloads - keep track of your Card amounts via the Wallet

- 1. Log into www.myscripwallet.com
- 2. Click on "My Wallet"
- 3. Choose ScripNow or Reload

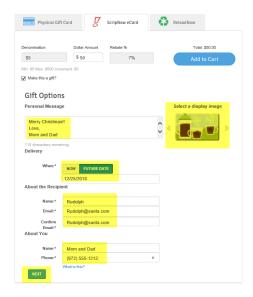

Monthly Statements

1. Each month the coordinator will run a report summing up all the Scrip rebates associated with the "Classroom/Group". This report will be sent to TAV to be applied to your account. Please allow a few days for them to apply towards your account. The coordinator will also send a monthly email to all those participating in the program listing the amounts earned each month.



2. The "Classroom/Group" value is what you need to remember because the monthly Excel file will have everyone's monthly rebates since 11/1/2014. You will need to search on your "Classroom/Group" to find your monthly amount.

PrestoPay Returns - Non-sufficient funds/frozen account

- 1. In the event we receive a PrestoPay Returned email, TAV will add the \$30 return fee charged by ShopWithScrip to your dues account. You will be notified by both ShopWithScrip and your coordinator and will need to rectify the issue immediately.
- 2. Please be aware that you are responsible to pay TAV back any amount you purchased plus the \$30 return fee. If payment is not made, your daughter will be in jeopardy of the NCAA Amateurism requirements as this would be considered salary or payment to the athlete.
- 3. If the amount is substantial or this occurs more than once, your PrestoPay account will be locked, and you must contact the coordinator to resume purchasing gift cards.

Reports you can run

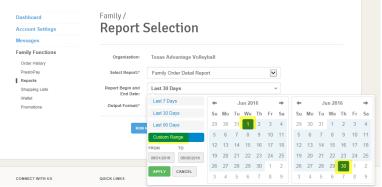

7.	There is a percentage taken out of your Scrip Rebates to cover program costs etc., so the report will NOT provide that information. Y will need to calculate that information yourself. Currently, we are taking 10% out to cover costs to run the program (this is non-profit your coordinator is a volunteer).
