



MOUND WESTONKA HOCKEY ASSOCIATION BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Overview

The Mound Westonka Hockey Association (MWHHA) Board of Directors (BOD) consists of voting members that govern the association according to its bylaws, rules, regulations and policies. This includes those policies adopted by District 3, Minnesota Hockey and USA Hockey.

How Board Members are Selected

Elections are held each spring and new board positions are typically available each year. The term of office for BOD members is three years. Contact the MWHHA Secretary for open positions and the election and appointment process.

Screening

All BOD members are subject to a bi-annual background screening per Minnesota Hockey (<http://screening.minnesotahockey.org/>) and SafeSport (<http://www.usahockey.com/safesportprogram>). BOD members are required to provide their SafeSport volunteer or coaching number

Meetings

Meetings typically occur on the third Monday of the month in the Thaler Arena Conference Room. Meetings start at 6:00pm and any member of the organization is welcome to attend. Management of responsibilities

The administrative operations of the Association are managed by the BOD. The on-ice operations of the Association are managed by the Hockey Operations Committee (HOC). The HOC reports to the BOD.

Participation Policy

It is expected that all BOD members attend at least 10 of the 12 monthly meetings. Members that are consistently absent will be asked to resign.

- Protect and ensure the financial health of the Association

 - Fundraising
 - Sponsorships
 - Scholarship and/or Financial Assistance programs
 - Conduct the Player Registration process
 - Govern the tryout process
