RE: FIELD GUIDELINES

The Town of Georgina through the Parks Department is making every effort to improve the quality of playing surfaces at sports fields in Georgina. To ensure that their work is not wasted by possible misuse, we would like to remind you of the field guidelines put in place by the Parks Department.

The following are playable guidelines that should be adhered to when playing on all ball diamond fields. Play on a soft, wet pitch/diamond, may cause significant damage to the turf and playing surfaces as well as endanger the safety of the users.

Therefore, play **must be suspended** if and when the following conditions exist:

- 1) ponding of water is visible on the pitch/diamond.
- 2) When water sponges up around the shoes of the players when walking over the pitch/diamond.
- 3) should 20% or more of the pitch/diamond be in one or a combination of the above conditions, then play **must not be permitted**.

Town of Georgina Sports areas have been provided with ample parking and should be used prior to using roadways or grassed areas. Please advise all participants that parking is restricted to designated parking areas only. Also driving on any Town of Georgina grounds will not be permitted except for approved Tournament set up only.

We look forward to a successful, dry and safe 2016 ball and soccer season
